

ALBEE IS FIRST TO OPEN HIS CAMPAIGN

Fair treatment for every citizen and better government under the new charter was pledged by H. R. Albee, candidate for mayor, in his speech in Gravel's hall, Montavilla, last night. He

spoke to a crowd of men and women, and later answered various questions concerning the commission plan and other municipal features.

Mr. Albee especially impressed upon those present the fact that it is of the utmost importance that the people shall select good officials to put the new charter into operation. Unless this is done, he declared, it will probably result in Portland having even worse government than it now has. He said that, in his opinion, the charter is a good thing for the city if properly administered and, to do this, he said, it is

necessary to have the right officials in office.

It is much better to do a lot of thinking now and to choose good officers than to have to apply the recall later at much expense and considerable trouble, he said.

Mr. Albee pledged himself to use the vast powers granted in the new charter with great caution, should he be elected mayor, and promised to have some of its features amended at the earliest possible time, at least at the first election. He said he would prefer, for example, to have the duties of each commissioner

set forth clearly in the charter than to have the power to assign vested in the mayor.

PEONAGE ADMITTED BY PHILIPPINE LEADER

Manila, May 13.—That a condition of peonage which borders on slavery is in existence in the Philippines was admitted today by Emilio Aguinaldo, the

former rebel, who from his residence at Baguio is beginning to figure again as a leader among those Filipinos who expect independence to follow the assumption of power by the Democrats at Washington.

Aguinaldo, whose propaganda for independence is being opposed by American residents in the islands, admits that practical slavery is common in the interior. He says he regrets the condition but is able to offer no hope that, if the Filipinos are left to shift for them-

selves a better state of affairs would prevail.

The American residents are asking upon the peonage condition as a reason why American sovereignty in the islands should continue indefinitely in order to prevent a lapse into industrial anarchy.

To prevent the drain on its population by the emigration of 200,000 persons a year, the Spanish government is planning extensive railroad and highway building schemes to give its workers employment.
