

AEROPLANE BUILT TO LIGHT LIKE CAT; STAYS

Connecticut Inventor Says His

(United Press Leased Wire.)

New York, July 12.—The problem of human flight is solved today, according to an announcement by Christopher J. Lake, whose son, Simon Lake of Bridgeport, Conn., is the inventor of a submarine torpedo boat now in use by the United States Navy. Constructed on an entirely new principle, the Lake aeroplane does not depend on its velocity to remain in the air. Father and son have been working on the problem for many years. Speaking at the Aero club of America here, the elder Lake said:

"This aeroplane will absolutely revolutionize aeronautics. It cannot fall."
