

GLACIER PARK IS TOURISTS' MECCA

Traffic Heavy, Says Carl Gray, President of Great Northern Road.

That general business conditions, as reflected in the volume of freight carried by his road, are good, is the declaration of Carl R. Gray, president of the Great Northern, who is in the city for a few days' conference with President Young of the S. P. & S. President Gray's visit at this time has no special significance. It being his policy to visit the Pacific coast terminals of the Great Northern four times a year. He came to Portland after visiting Vancouver and Seattle.

While the through passenger traffic to the Pacific coast is not all that is to be desired this summer, President Gray states that the tourist travel to the Glacier National park is sufficient to tax the accommodations there to the limit. He calls attention to the fact that Glacier park is not regarded in the light of a counter attraction to Yellowstone National park, claiming that the natural advantages of both places are so different as to make both well worth while. Before the summer tourist season of 1914 arrives, President Gray states that additional facilities for taking care of visitors to Glacier National park will be established.

Trouble among the members of the bricklayers' union and the contractors in the provinces of Alberta, Manitoba and Saskatchewan is expected within a short time, as a result of the stand taken by the contractors, refusing to deal with the bricklayers as a union. The contractors have offered wages of 70 cents an hour, while the members of the union demand 75 cents an hour.

On their annual outing as guests of President J. D. Farrell and the O.-W. R. & N. company, about 200 institutional children left on the steamer "Hessalo," Ash street dock, at 2 o'clock this afternoon, for a trip down the river. A feast of fun and good things to eat will be furnished the youngsters, for whom the outing is a big event in their lives. On today's outing will be 20 children

from the Multnomah Detention home, 15 from the Boys' and Girls' Aid society, and about 130 from other homes and institutions, principally the Peoples' Institute. The youngsters will be given the best of care and attention and nothing will be left undone to make their outing just one round of good times. President Farrell is out of the city, but other company officials will go along to assist the institution heads in looking after the young excursionists.

61 MOTHERS WILL BE ON THE PENSION LIST

With the signing of nine widows' pensions this afternoon and the granting of eight more next Thursday, Judge Gatens, of the juvenile court, will have provided 61 mothers with assistance in accordance with the pension law. The total monthly amount of pensions will be \$1320. The nine to be signed today have already been paid and the signing is the mere formality. The eight for next Thursday have been passed upon favorably. One of these pensions may yet be denied should the mother desire to keep on drawing \$20 a month from the county board of relief. She would get but \$17.50 a month under the pension law as she has but two children and as her case is deserving and the extra

money is necessary she may not accept the pension. The committee recommended that a pension be granted to the woman who refused to give up a \$40 position and remain at home with her children. She would get but \$17.50 as she has but two children. The committee took the stand that the law was not meant for women who left home to work but for women who would remain at home and care for their children. The attorney general held that the pension might be granted. Final decision on this will be made by Judge Gatens. The total number of applications has reached 212.
