

SAN FRANCISCO WANTS SMALL SIZED BONDS

San Francisco, Aug. 5.—Turned down by banks and big investors who will not purchase the city's improvement bonds in \$1000 blocks and larger, San Francisco's supervisors today are considering the issuance of municipal

bonds in \$10, \$25 and \$50 denominations, the bonds to carry five per cent. Work here has stopped on three big municipal buildings because the city can't get ready cash. Supervisor McLaren made the proposal for small bonds for the small investor. "Besides," said he, "the contractors on the city works will be glad to take these bonds and use them in payment of material and labor." The city finance committee will decide definitely on the plan. BRIDGE WATER PIPES NOW ORDERED OPENED

County Commissioner Hart yesterday afternoon ordered M. J. Murnane, superintendent of bridges and ferries, to temporarily open the water pipes on the bridges owned by the county, pending the settlement of the dispute between the county and the city as to which party shall pay the water rent on the structures. This move was taken by Commissioner Hart as a preventive measure against a possible repetition of a disaster like that which temporarily put the steel bridge out of commission last week. Murnane made a report on these conditions immediately following that fire, to the county commissioner, and that body ordered him to make a more detailed investigation and submit recommendations. SCENIC BOULEVARD TO LINNONTON IS PROPOSED

Residents along the heights between Portland and Linnonton are proposing to build a scenic boulevard 12 miles long to follow the hills above the present Linnonton road. Yesterday property owners conferred with Commissioner Brewster with a view to having the city pave and maintain the boulevard as soon as the grading is completed. The people of Linnonton, according to Mr. Brewster, are planning to come into Portland

soon. If this action is taken it would remove any obstacles in the way of Portland taking over the new proposed boulevard.

SPEEDOMETERS SHOW DIFFERENT MARKINGS

Major A. S. Flemming of Vancouver barracks was before the court for speeding yesterday afternoon on Williams avenue. Motorcycle officers Coulter and Bewley followed the major 12 blocks and said his speed was 30

miles an hour. Major Flemming made his speedometer registered 15 miles an hour, which is within the law. A question of accuracy arose between the army officer and the motorcycle officers, in which they made a test. It was found the speedometer of Major Flemming registered under the standard speedometers on the motorcycles. The judge found Major Flemming guilty, but suspended sentence.
