The bill this afternoon includes a 2:08 pace, a 2:15 trot, two running races, an exhibition by the Guinness Wonder, songs by the Portland Ad club and a

The awards for the highest scoring babies, judged Thursday and Friday, will be announced at 4 o'clock this afternoon. Two babies are tied for sweepstakes prize and they must be rescored to see if there may not be some error. The winner will be announced at 4 o'clock.

The prizes will be awarded by Dr. Mary Madigan and O. M. Plummer, of Portland.

All awards for prizes have been made, with the exception of first prize to the best individual farm exhibit. This was given by the judges to Mrs. Antone Farin, but the judges were not informed of certain conditions, so a protest arose. It is probable that she will be permitted to keep the silver cup given by the

O. W. R. & N. Railroad company and enough money to repay for the work in making the exhibit, but there is to be a readjustment of placing the honor of the first prize money.

The fair has been very successful, especially the races, which seem to attract the people more than do excellent farm and orchard exhibits. Many of the first specimens will be taken from various exhibits and sent east to the

land shows given by the various railroads. Boxes for shipment have been provided and are already on the grounds. While the farm and Grange exhibits were not so numerous this year as last, the standard was really higher. The Grange exhibits keeps many farmers from entering the individual farm exhibit contest, as his efforts go to the Grange display.

**CHINA WILL EMPLOY
200 GERMAN OFFICERS**
