#### "SHELL ROCK" ROAD QUESTION MUST BE DECIDED IN COURT

(Continued From Page One.) the ground that the district court did not have jurisdiction and that the petition of the company did not state sufficient cause for action. The supreme court holds that the lower court has jurisdiction and that the petition con-

tained sufficient cause of action. This bit of proposed road is the stumpling point in the way of the completion of the scenic highway along the Columbia river between Portland and Hood River. It is the Shell Rock road, loward the construction of which S. Benson, the wealthy timber owner, contributed \$10,000 to defray the expense of convict labor on the road. Claims Interference.

The railroad company objects to giving up any of its right of way for the highway, alleging that it would interfere with its plan to double track its line, and would also interfere with its single track line.

In the opinion handed down by the supreme court today, which was written by Justice McNary and concurred in by Chief Justice McBride and Justices Bean and Eakin, the question of the jurisdiction of the lower court is the chief point decided, but when the case goes back to the lower court the merits of the case, as to whether the county can reappropriate property already devoted to a public use, will

The supreme court holds that the circult court has jurisdiction because the real questions at issue cannot be decided under the road laws guiding the county court in laying out high-

"No issue can be made by plaintiff before the county court on the question of the appropriation of its property," says the opinion. "The company has under the statute, neither the right to petition for a road or to remonstrate against the establishment of one, as it not a free-holder residing withing the road district. Nor can that all importaut question be determined, whether the county can re-appropriate property already devoted to a public use."

Would "Incite to Action." Taking up the other ground of de-murrer, the question of the sufficiency

of the complaint, the court says: "We think that complaint contains matters which, if true, would necessarily incite the conscience of a court of equity into action. We have no hesitancy in declaring the law of this state will not permit any corporation, whatever be its legal or political character, to deprive a railroad, beyond its legitimate needs, of its right of way longitudinally when the property is being used by such railroad in the performance of its publle functions as a common carrier.

"Whether an attempt of that character is being made by defendants as alleged in the bill, or to what extent a reappropriation can be made, if at all, are questions which of necessity, must arise from the issues hereafter to be made in the litigation. These considerations are sufficient in our opinion, to justify a direction that the demurrer be overruled, and defendants be permitted to answer or otherwise plead in a manner consistent with this opinion."

Abel of Johns Hopkins university. The blood, by Dr. Abel's device, is conducted through glass tubes for study by specialists. The device has been used successfully on criminals.
