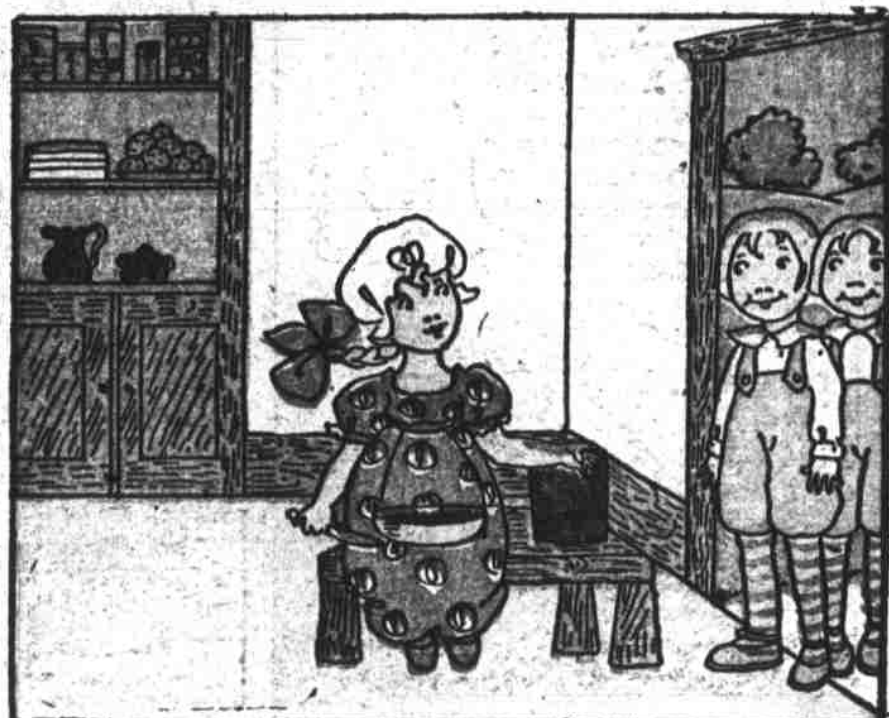


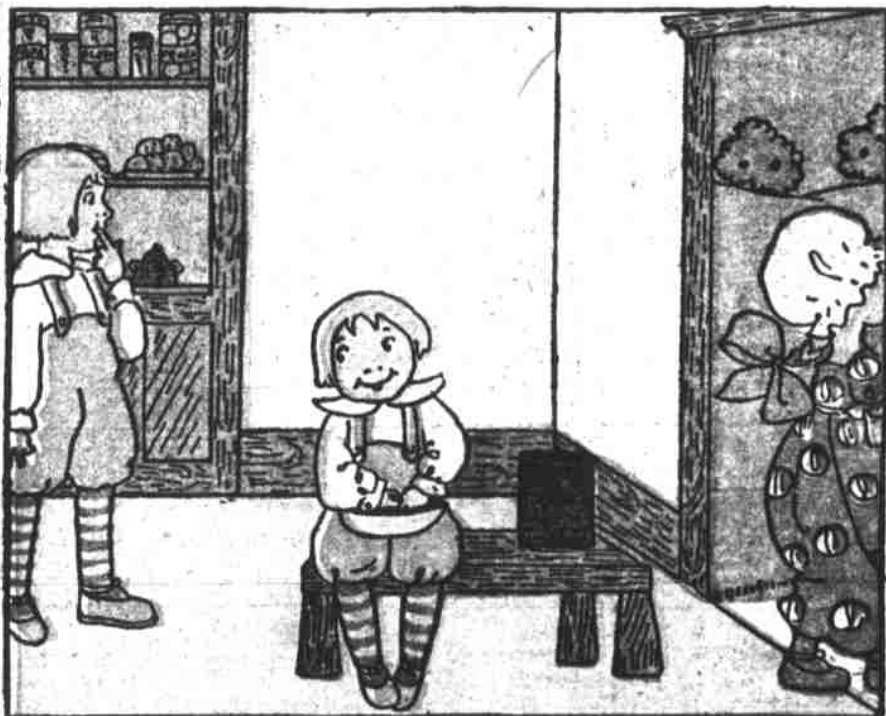
SNOOKS AND SNICKS GO TO SUSIE'S AID



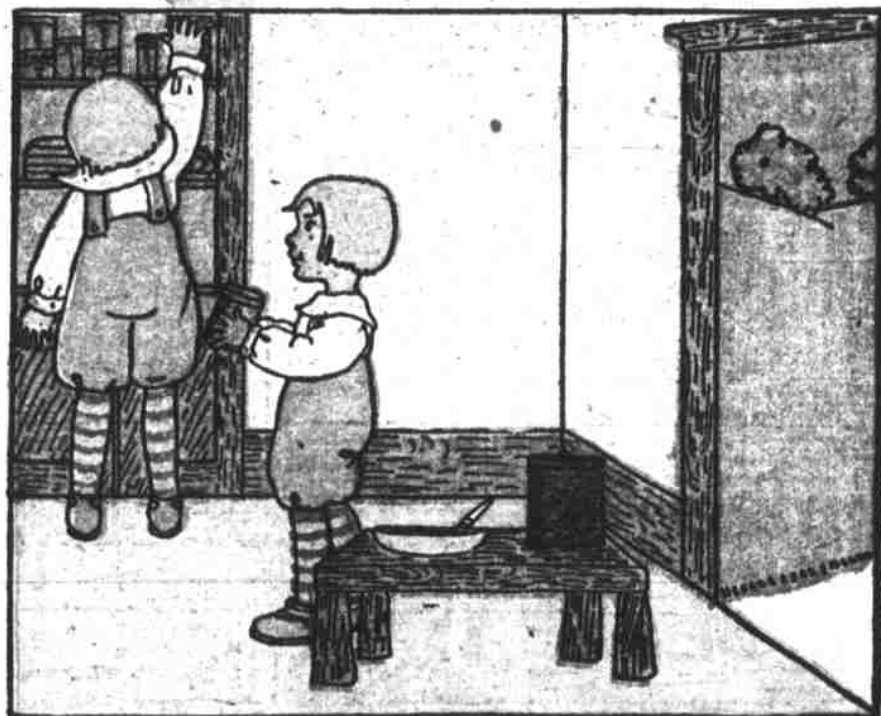
"I have to go down to the store,"

While I am gone away."



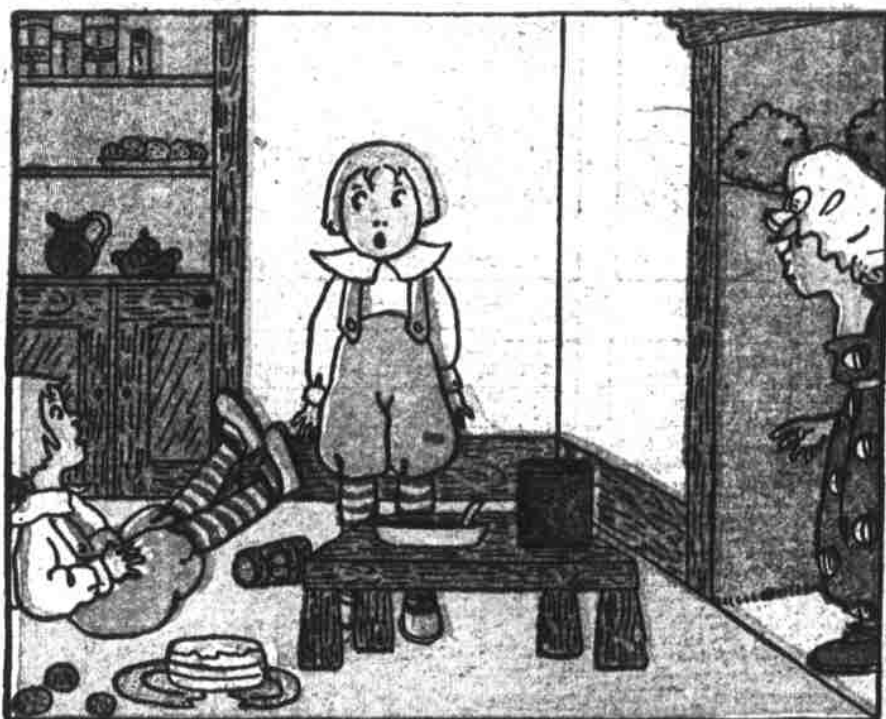
Said Susie, "Seeding raisins is
