

OFFICIALS OF BAKER COUNTY ARE FLAYED BY GOVERNOR WEST

Executive Justifies His Action in Employing Martial Law at Copperfield.

"If they get a judgment against Lawson, or Hobbs, or the militia, I'll pay it. I wouldn't want any better monument than a decision in favor of the cutthroats at Copperfield who are breaking the hearts of mothers and ruining 13-year-old boys."

Governor West used the expression during his address yesterday before the Ad club when he explained why he established martial law at Copperfield, on the edge of the Snake River.

His action he declared was due to the fact that in the saloons operated by the mayor, by a councilman who is an ex-convict not yet in reprobation of his citizenship and others the business of vending booze was extended to little boys who got "full" as good an opportunity as their elders to drink and to gaze upon wall pictures displayed on the walls.

"Baker Wide Open." Then he told how there was evidence to show that Baker was running wide open; Huntington was running wide open; laws were persistently being violated at Copperfield; yet the officials of the county pleaded ignorance. It was his duty, he declared, to interfere, and he merely did his duty. He sent Fern Hobbs, his secretary, because she has a record for results. The governor spoke epigrammatically. Some of his expressions were:

"The governor has as much right to use military force to enforce the laws as a sheriff has to use deputies. If there is anything that makes me sick it is one of those officials who always needs evidence and never knows that law violations are going on."

Baker was running wide open. What made me run sore was to be played for a sucker by the district attorney. I hate to be gold bricked. I hate to have anything "slipped over" on me.

Huntington in Limerick. "Huntington was running wide open and a justice of the peace was peddling booze to houses of prostitution. I am long on short cuts. If you think 'damn it,' say it."

"If anyone should be subject to capital punishment, it is that one who makes excuses. I had two good huskies at Copperfield, not militiamen, but special agents who had instructions if anyone opened his mouth to insult Miss Hobbs to knock his block off."

"I thought we might as well use the ribbons and flowers we used to decorate the bars to celebrate Hobbs' coming for the funeral. Guns Are Taken Away. The militia gathered the guns from the homes while the people were attending the meeting in the dance hall that was used as city hall. Then they relieved the men at the dance hall of their guns, and they got about 200 in all. We gave back the guns but not the booze; guns without booze are not, as a rule, very harmful."

"I am not running for anything; I am running away from this job as fast as I can get out of it. I am not going to raid the tall tower. I'd like to, but I won't. They are perfectly safe as long as they obey the laws."

Rabbi Kaplan of San Francisco and Rev. W. A. Spaulding of the United Presbyterian church also addressed the meeting yesterday.

HOOD VALLEY FARMERS WANT POWER PLANT

Cooperative Scheme of Procedure Meets With General Approval.

(Special to The Journal.) Hood River, Or., Jan. 22.—A mass meeting of the farmers of the Hood River valley was held at Odell for the purpose of considering the proposition of the installation of a cooperative light and power plant for the entire Hood River valley. About 150 of the leading farmers attended the meeting, and a rough estimate was received from an electrical engineer indicating that the citizens of the valley, through a cooperative light and power plant, should receive electric energy at approximately one half the price that is now being paid. A central committee was appointed consisting of members from the several sections of the valley to act with a committee of business men from the city to proceed in the perfecting of the organization. Estimates have been made that a plant can be installed to develop 1200 horsepower at a cost of approximately \$5000.

Business men of the city have endorsed the proposed cooperative light and power plant. It is charged that the commercial lighting rate in effect in the city of Hood River is excessive, and several of the merchants have pledged from \$500 to \$2000 each to assist the farmers in getting the new plant.
