

SONS OF JOVE WILL SEE MOVING PICTURES

Films to Show Views of Famous Los Angeles Aqueduct.

Members of the Sons of Jove, a national organization composed of men engaged in electrical pursuits, will have a moving picture show as the feature of their bi-weekly luncheon in the blue room of the Multnomah hotel next Wednesday.

The film to be run at the luncheon will show views of the famous Los Angeles aqueduct, through which the city of Los Angeles obtains its water supply from a mountain stream 250 miles away. Two big power developments on the aqueduct, one of which, generating 37,500 horse power, is the first unit in the Los Angeles municipal electric system, will be shown in detail.

Burnett Goodwin, statesman of the organization in Portland, will preside at the luncheon and explain the pictures. The luncheon will be open to any persons who are interested in the topic to be depicted by the films. For this and moving pictures to be given at future banquets, the Sons of Jove have built a moving picture booth of their own.

The officers of the Sons of Jove, which has about 150 members in this city, are: Burnett Goodwin, of the Northwestern Electric company, statesman; George N. Barker, Portland, manager of the General Electric company, secretary-treasurer, and an executive committee composed of J. E. Davidson, general manager of the Pacific Power & Light company; E. J. West, efficiency manager of the Portland Railway, Light & Power company, and A. S. Moody, assistant manager of the General Electric company.
