

INSPECTORS FOR CITY AND COUNTY NAMED

Appointments Made by State Horticultural Inspector.

J. E. Stansbery, state horticultural inspector, has been named city horticultural inspector, and C. O. Windle, county fruit inspector, has been named Mr. Stansbery's deputy. Mayor Albee made the appointments Thursday and the horticultural ordinance, an emergency measure passed by the city commission Wednesday, is now being enforced.

Stansbery and Windle serve the city without compensation so far as the city is concerned. They are the only licensed city or county ordinance providers, mostly for the enforcement of the state horticultural statutes. The ordinance goes further and requires the use of professional tree sprayers to secure a permit to carry on this work. Mr. Stansbery says that he has found a number of people who are willing to do the work using improper spray solutions and spraying poor work generally and before the trees are properly inspected. He says they will have to satisfy the city inspector as to their ability to do a good job.

When a job of spraying is done, Mr. Stansbery says, the owner of the trees should get a receipt with the permit number on it. Then if the work is done with good results and their office is notified, we will know who did it and start prosecution."
