**ANOTHER CLEAN-UP EXPEDITION IN VIEW FOR MISS F. HOBBS**

Alleged Bad Conditions at Cove Will Be Investigated by Governor's Secretary.

(Salem Bureau of The Journal.)  
 Salem, Or., Feb. 20.—In response to an appeal for aid from a mother who says she is often compelled to defend her children from attacks by her drunken husband, to whom the saloon keeper, at Cove, in Union county, persists in selling liquor in spite of her protests, and who obtained no relief when she appealed to the district attorney, Governor West is preparing to send Miss Fern Hobbs to Cove next Monday to make an investigation, and if the laws are being disregarded on other shacks-up in an eastern Oregon town may be expected.  
 The woman who appealed to the governor is Mrs. Amy Valentine. She says: "I have tried every other means (and failed) for help in my trouble. My last appeal is to you for advice. My husband is a drunkard and because the habit was formed, (unknown to me) before marriage, the law will not free me. He is drunk for weeks at a time. I sent a written order two different times to the Cove saloon-keeper, begging him not to let my husband have liquor, as it made him dangerous. Often I have to stand between him and an open knife or loaded gun, and my children. He disregarded my orders. Then, I went to our state attorney. He said I had a good case, but I would have to make a civil suit of it. The state would not bother with

it. Will you please advise me what to do. Yours in an earnest appeal."  
 Governor West said he understood that the precinct in which Cove is situated had voted dry, but that the vote had been disregarded. This point will be investigated by Miss Hobbs, who led the invasion of Copperfield a few weeks ago when the governor clamped the lid on that town because the liquor laws were being violated and the town was in control of a saloon clique.  
 Miss Hobbs will be instructed also to find out why the district attorney has been indifferent, if it is true that Cove should be dry territory or that a saloon keeper is selling liquor to a habitual drunkard when requested not to. If there is foundation for the woman's letter, there is every indication that something is going to happen at Cove.  
 Miss Hobbs will leave Monday for Cove.

**Two More Filled.**  
 Salem, Or., Feb. 20.—Attorney General A. M. Crawford filed his declaration of candidacy for the Republican nomination for governor yesterday afternoon. He asks to have printed on the ballot after his name the words: "Economic administration; lower taxes; progressive laws and strict enforcement."  
 O. P. Hoff, state labor commissioner, who is a candidate for reelection on the Republican ticket, filed his declaration yesterday afternoon. His slogan is: "Continued fairness, economical, progressive administration; strict enforcement of laws within court's interpretation."

**Complaint Is Filed.**  
 Salem, Or., Feb. 20.—A complaint, signed by 21 persons of Hood River, against the alleged unequal and unfair rates charged by the Hood River Gas & Electric company and the Hydro-Electric company, has been filed with the state railroad commission. Some time ago the commission, after a hearing, ordered the companies to install meter rates in the place of flat rates for electric service.
