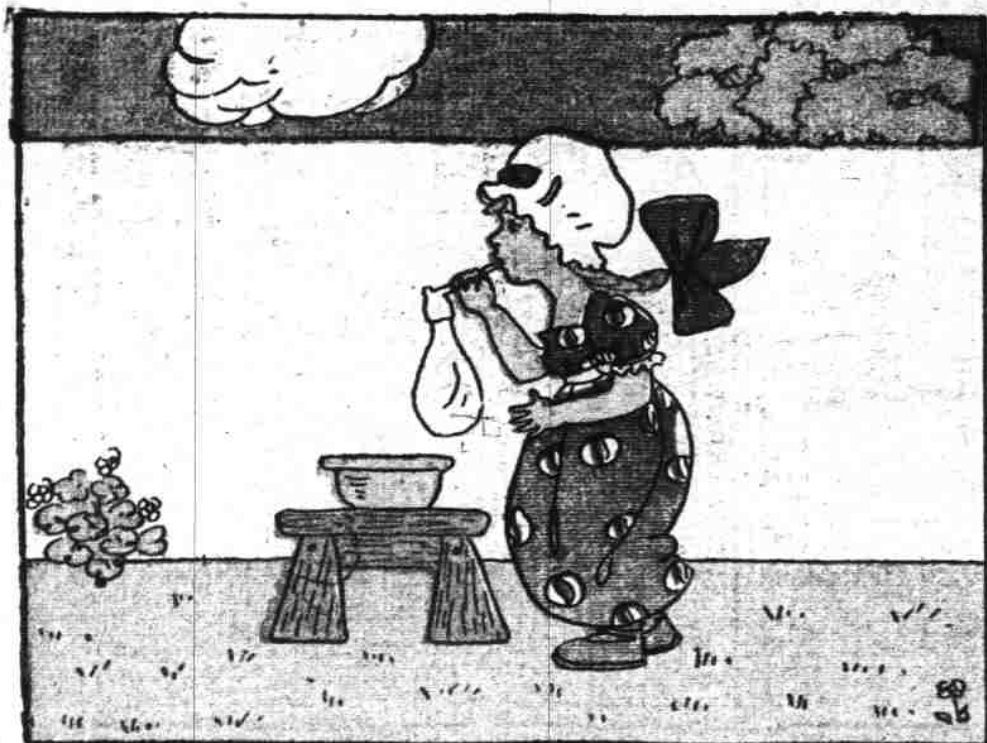


SNOOKS AND SNICKS AT SUSIE'S BUBBLE PARTY



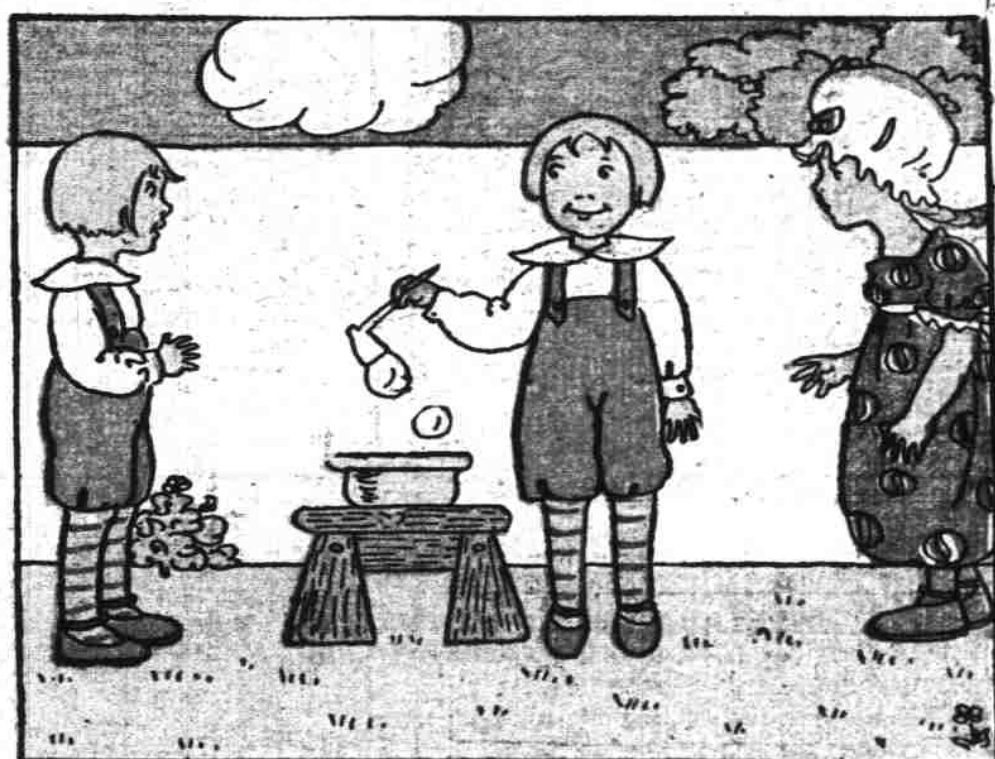
Out in the garden little Sue

And some 'light on the ground.



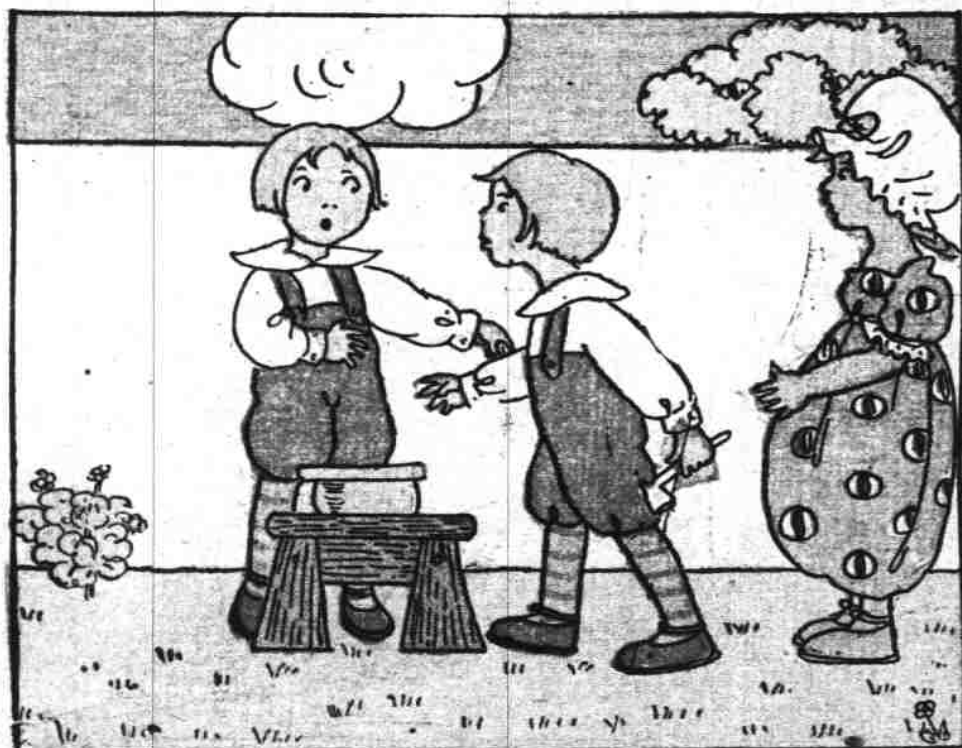
Along comes Snicks, who watches her.

Would mount up to the sky."



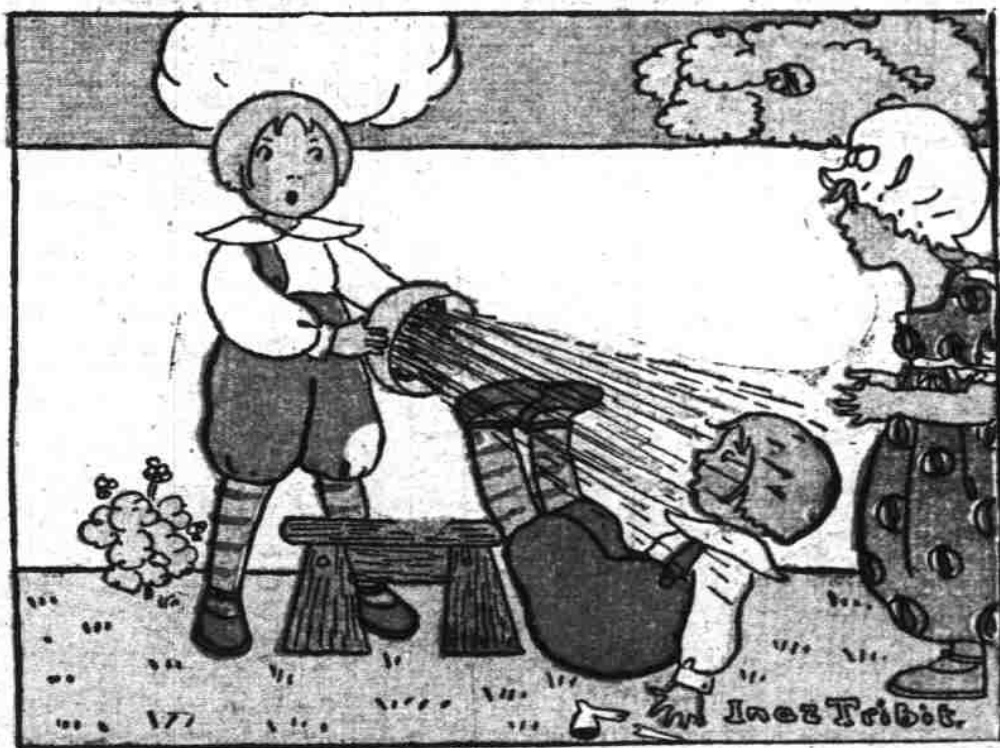
So Susie handed him her pipe,
