

CENTRAL OREGON IS COMING TO FRONT

Drewsey, Or., March 6.—A movement is on foot here to organize a company to build an electric railway from Riverside, a town on the new Oregon-Eastern railroad, up the middle fork of the Malheur river, past Drewsey to the timber belt. The power will be furnished by the plant to be installed above the Ott sawmill by John E. Johnson & Sons.

J. L. Sitts, merchant and stockman, is promoting the railway movement. The proposed road, would be 50 miles long, water grade all the way, and would tap what is probably the largest body of pine timber in the state.

The Johnson plant will also furnish power for the electric road from the Oregon-Eastern main line to Burns, if the effort to bond Burns to build such a road is successful.

HOOD RIVER COUNCIL HAS COMPLICATIONS

Hood River, Or., March 6.—It is said the proceedings of the city council since the time of the canvass of the vote last year have not been legal, because the council failed in the canvass of the vote declaring the councilmen elected to designate which term should be given to the councilmen-elect. At present they are each serving for the same term of years. Mayor Reed has suggested that one of the councilmen resign, and the mayor would then appoint him for the short term, which would adjust the matter for the present, at least.

Centralia Man Withdraws

Centralia, Wash., March 6.—J. E. Raught has withdrawn from the race for school director, the election for which will be held here Saturday. The withdrawal of Raught leaves O. O. Ort and George Barner as candidates for the three year term and J. C. Watson for the one year term. Barner, who is being backed by the Socialists, graduated from the Centralia high school last June.

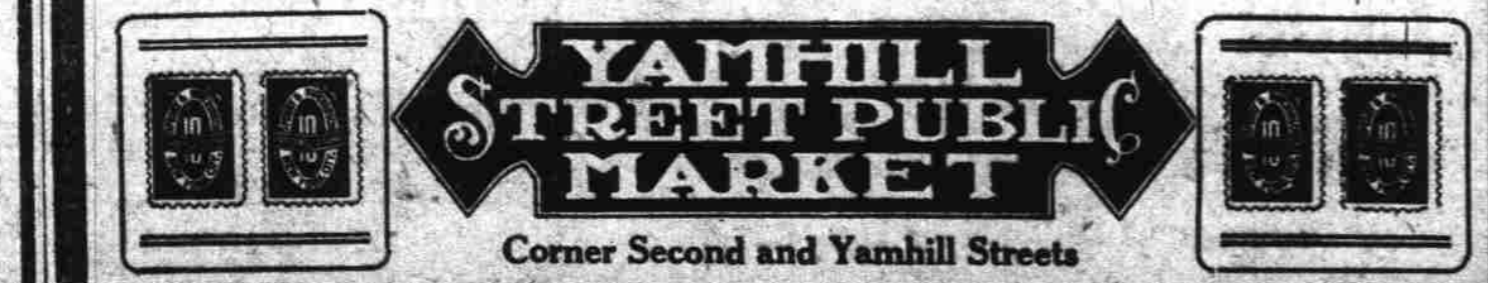
