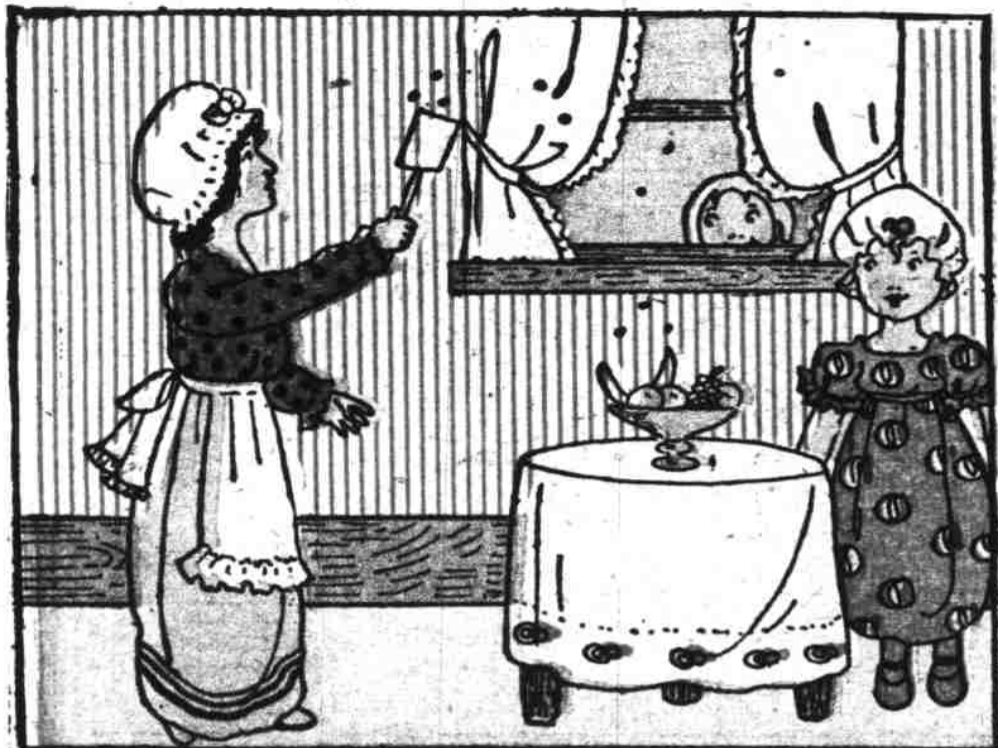


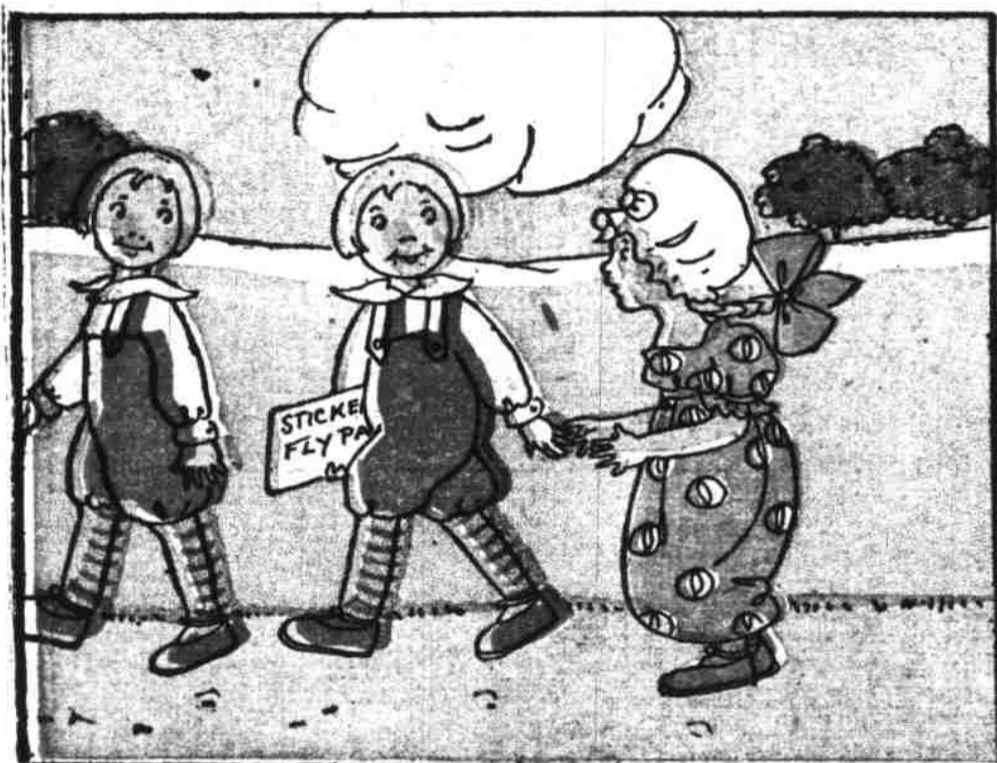
## SNOOKS AND SNICKS STICK UP THE GOSSIPS



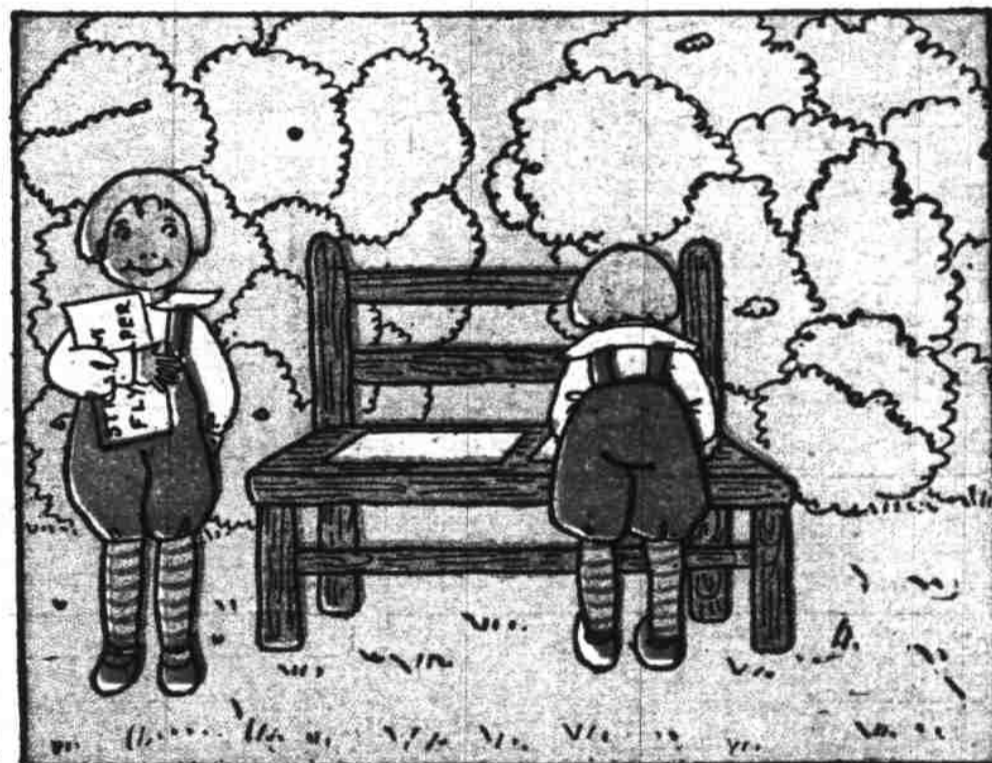
"Dear me!" said Susie's mother, "but
