Weather Conditions.

A trough-shaped depression extends from Alberta south to Arizona and the western high pressure area now overlies the plains. A storm area of low pressure is moving over western Pennsylvania. Light rain has fallen in Washington, western Oregon and northern California and showers have fallen in Tennessee, Iowa, Illinois, Pennsylvania and the District of Columbia. It is warmer over the upper drainage areas of the Columbia and Snake rivers.

The conditions are favorable for rain in this district during the next 24 to 36 hours with lower temperatures in Idaho.

Shippers' Forecast.

Protect shipments as far north as Seattle. Light minimum temperature of 34 degrees; northeast to Spokane, 45 degrees; southeast to Boise, 40 degrees; south to Ashland, 38 degrees. Minimum temperature at Portland tonight, about 50 degrees.
