

CANDIDATE SAYS HE INTENDS TO SUPPORT NOMINEE OF PARTY

Good Feeling Among Contestants Is Declared to Be Best Augury for Party Success.

SITUATION IS SUMMED UP

Victory Next Friday Declared Largely to Depend Upon How State Outside of Portland Goes.

Stating that if defeated for the Democratic nomination for governor he will support whomever is the party's choice and believing that the good feeling among the Democratic candidates augurs well for the election of a Democrat governor in November no matter who is nominated, John Manning, candidate for the Democratic nomination, has sized up the political situation as he sees it, and is confident of success.

"Frankly, the way I have the situation sized up is that the choice for governor depends upon the plurality Dr. Smith is likely to have outside Multnomah county. It must be 2000 or more votes over me, or I will surely win, as I believe I will have that much plurality in Multnomah, with 19,000 votes cast of the 17,000 registered.

"Many of my friends who have gone over the situation carefully believe that I will come to this county very few votes, in any, behind Dr. Smith. In the state in the presidential primary, when there was also a warmly contested struggle for senatorial honors, only 37 per cent of the registered vote was cast at the primary and this included Multnomah, where 65 per cent of the vote is usually cast.

"If this percentage holds good this election, and interest in the result seems no greater than heretofore, there will not be over 6000 votes cast in all the eastern Oregon counties. In these votes, in my opinion, based upon a fair knowledge of conditions, Dr. Smith and Judge Bennett will lead the race about neck-and-neck and I will not be very far behind.

"I will then have a majority vote in Coos, Curry, Jackson, Klamath, Columbia, Marion and Washington, as well as Multnomah. I will have a plurality in Douglas and Josephine and will break about even with Dr. Smith, in my opinion, in the two counties of Polk. The only county in western Oregon in which Judge Bennett will have a larger vote than myself is in Linn, but I believe Dr. Smith will lead in that county.

"Judge Bennett is strong in spots but the localities are widely separated and knowledge of this fact, of course, compels my admission that the contest is between Dr. Smith and myself and that if I am not nominated as the Democratic candidate, Judge Bennett will bear the standard of our party."

Shepherd Attacks Political Opponents

Congressional Candidate, With Brass Band as Added Attraction, Plays McArthur and Lafferty in Speeches.

Charging C. N. McArthur with neglecting the interests of the people in the last legislature and A. W. Lafferty with having accomplished nothing for Oregon during two terms in congress, George S. Shepherd, Republican candidate for congress, made a number of outdoor speeches Monday night in the central district of the city. Mr. Shepherd was accompanied by a brass band of automobiles, in one of which was a brass band, and wherever he went he was immediately surrounded by a big crowd.

At First and Madison streets and again at Second and Morrison, and First and Sherman, the speaker found a street full of cheering voters. "This is a critical time in Oregon's history," said Mr. Shepherd. "Puget Sound and San Francisco are both making desperate efforts to corral the deep-sea shipping of the Pacific and if we fail to make the Columbia river navigable for big ships we shall lose the bulk of our foreign commerce to other Pacific ports."

Mr. Shepherd addressed the longshoremen yesterday noon, and also spoke at a labor meeting last night.

Cabaret Men Lose Suit for Damages

Demurrer of Owner of Property to Complaint Is Sustained by Circuit Judge McGinn.

The demurrer of Seth Riggs to the suit of Fritz & Russell, proprietors of a saloon at Second and Burnside streets, for \$3000 damages on the allegation that Riggs, from whom they leased their building, caused that amount in loss during the last 18 months through his Prohibition activities, was sustained yesterday by Circuit Judge McGinn. This ends the case unless an appeal is taken to the supreme court. Riggs demurred on the ground that the complaint was not sufficient.

In making his decision, Judge McGinn declared that every man had a perfect right to his own principles and could do as he pleased in carrying them out as long as he remained within legal bounds. It had been pleaded in the complaint that Riggs broke his contract by his activities. Judge McGinn failed to uphold this contention.

Expediting Transfer Of Locks Is Object

F. B. L. & P. Co. Representatives and Owners of Paper Mill Leaseholds at Oregon City Confer.

Whether there shall be speed in meeting the government's objections to the deed to the Oregon City locks seems to rest with the paper mills at Oregon City. 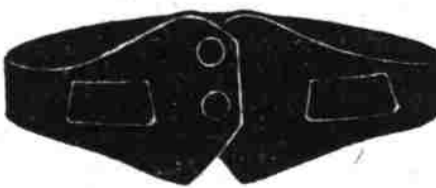
