Warrant Issued for Secretary of Elks

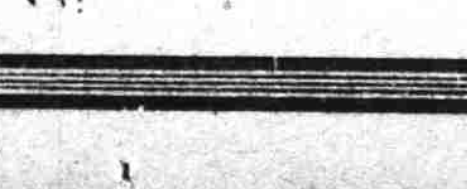
