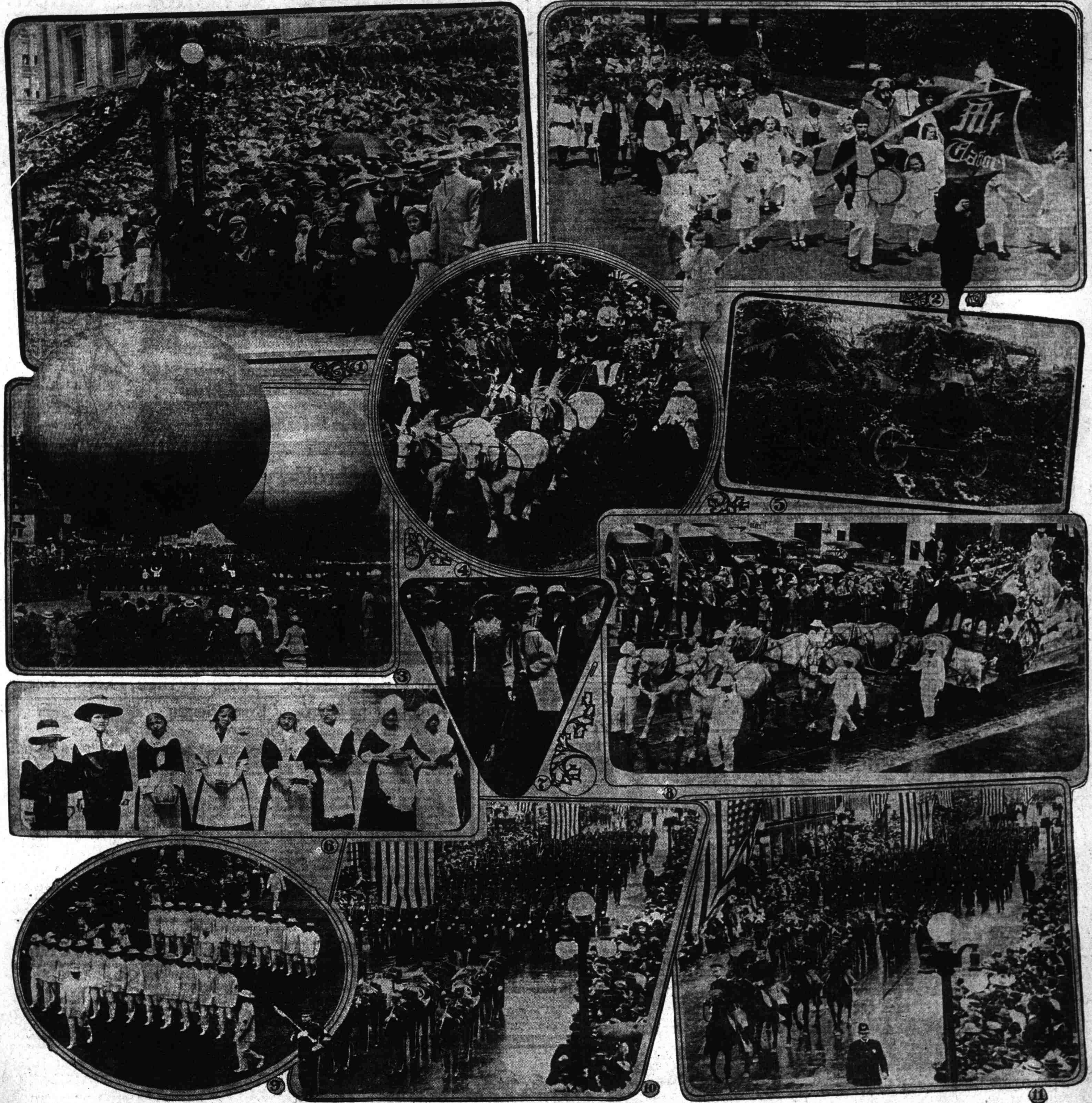


SPECTACULAR EVENTS THAT ENLIVENED GAY MIDSUMMER HOLIDAYS
