

FLEGEI POINTS OUT NEEDS OF NATION AND HOME STATE

Democratic Nominee for Congress Supports Wilson Administration.

ADDRESSES JACKSON CLUB

Improvement of Water Ways Said to Be Most Important Question Before Oregon Today.

The needs of the nation and of Oregon were pointed out by A. F. Flegel, Democratic nominee for congress from this district, in an address read before the Jackson club at its ratification banquet Friday night.

Mr. Flegel was unable to be present in person, but his address was read for him by Thomas G. Greene, a fellow orator. It virtually amounted to a declaration of principles, and puts Mr. Flegel's candidacy squarely before the voters of his party.

After pledging his support to the administration of President Wilson and the national platform of the Democratic party, although reserving the right to exercise his judgment on matters of principle, and decrying blind partisanship and obstructive tactics, Mr. Flegel said:

Harbor Improvement Urged.

The most important question for Oregon and the third congressional district, in my opinion, is the continued improvement of our water ways and harbors; and as our harbors and rivers are improved so will our state develop. The rivers are the arteries through which flow the commerce of the world—the very life of progress and development—and, if I am elected to congress, I will cooperate with every agency in the state to make our rivers and harbors suitable for the requirement of commerce, with the hope that ultimately any ship in the world may steam into the harbor and anchor with a certain assurance of a safe harbor and passage to the sea.

Stating that a merchant marine was equally as important as the improvement of rivers and harbors, Mr. Flegel scored the present laws as useless, and suggested the enactment of legislation to put the shipping of the United States on the same basis as that of other countries.

Referring to the trusts, he said:

Government Control Favored.

Trusts, public service corporations and large aggregations of wealth invested in the industries and commerce of the country—interest in which should be subject to the control and supervision of the federal government, and the interstate commerce act should be extended to cover all such industries, or other laws should be passed which will accomplish that result.

"This country can never be happy nor prosperous unless the laboring classes are well paid and are provided with reasonably safe conditions of employment. I believe the labor unions of the United States have done more for the improvement of the condition of the laboring classes than all other agencies combined. I know the intelligence of wealth in the hands of industrial workers, and the helplessness of individual workmen in dealing with wealth. I also know that labor unions have been, in many cases, intolerant masters.

Disputes between capital and labor, he pointed out, should be settled along broad lines of humanity, each side recognizing the other's rights, and if unable to come to an amicable agreement, they should arbitrate. He said that the public is usually the greatest sufferer from conflicts between capital and labor, and that they have a right and will exercise their right to be heard in the settlement of the controversies.

Child Labor Law.

I favor a federal child labor law and a workmen's compensation act. Next in importance to our rivers and harbors is the question of conservation. Oregon is vitally interested in the conservation of her forests, her water power, her arid lands, her irrigated lands, her coal and her oil lands. Oregon is interested in a different way from the other states of the United States. I favor for Oregon a conservation which means the use of these natural products without wasting them and will consider it my duty to secure for Oregon such laws, rules and regulations as will permit the use of all natural resources for the benefit of the people of Oregon.

The arid lands of this state, which can be reclaimed by irrigation, require special attention, and I consider no one question of greater importance to the state or more difficult of solution. I favor reclaiming by irrigation all such lands through national irrigation projects, supplemented in certain cases by state or private enterprise.

I favor homestead laws which will remove many of the present unreasonable restrictions upon bona fide homesteaders in acquiring government land, and I favor such laws as will make it impossible for speculators to acquire lands. I favor opening for settlement to all homesteaders every section of land within our national forest reservations, which is more valuable for agriculture than for timber or minerals.

Repeal is Advocated.

I will favor the repeal of all laws which permit corporations to surrender to the United States valuable lands within the limits of the government reservations, and which permit the taking in lieu thereof the most valuable land, subject to entry, outside of reservations. I favor acquiring all lands within government reservations and needed by the government by condemnation and not by exchange.

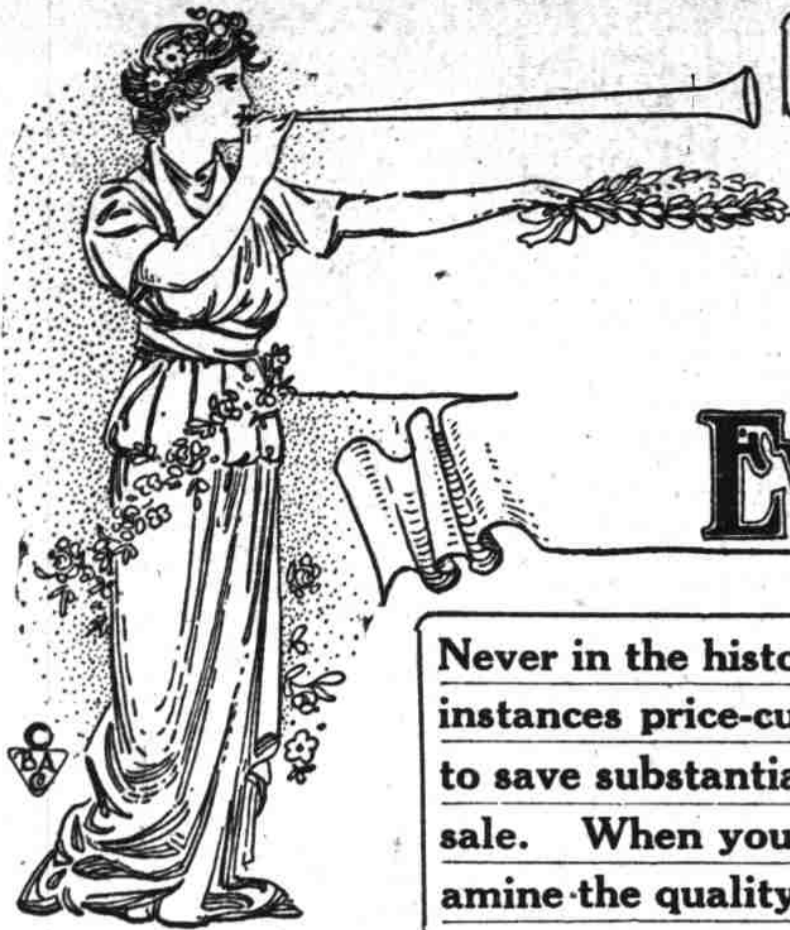
I believe the conditions in Alaska warrant the national government in aiding the development of that country and making it possible to put the vast natural resources stored therein to beneficial use, and that the coal mines of Alaska should be opened up as to furnish the Pacific coast with cheap fuel for use in our homes and all manufacturing purposes.

Mr. Flegel further expressed himself as being in favor of direct legislation, of national woman suffrage, of local option, of the prohibition of federal licenses for the sale of liquor in dry territory and strict enforcement of the Webb law prohibiting the shipment of liquor into dry districts. He declared for the strictest economy in public expenditures and the reduction of the burden of public taxation and added that he had no personal, private or special interest to serve, and that his object will be to serve the third congressional district, and the state of Oregon with credit to his constituents and to his country. He concluded by promising to make a vigorous campaign.
