

**CHINESE FLOUR TRADE**  
ATTRACTS ATTENTION  
OF OTHER SELLERS

Inroads Made on Trade Long  
Held Exclusively by Pacific  
Coast States.

**BRITISH COLONIES SELL**

Canada and Australia Find Market for  
Product; Evidently Intend to Fol-  
low Advantage Gained.

(Washington Bureau of The Journal.)  
Washington, July 2.—Flour has long  
been one of the principal exports from  
the Pacific coast to China, but other  
markets are making bids for this busi-  
ness, and they are securing a consid-  
erable share of the trade. Various  
reasons contribute to the inroads upon  
the Pacific coast export business in  
flour, one of which is the reputation  
that has been given the flour from  
California, Oregon and Washington of  
not having sufficient gluten content.  
However, this was the only reason,  
could be overcome, perhaps, by a  
judicious blending of wheats entering  
into the manufacture of the flour.

During the year 1913 the importations  
of flour at Hongkong were valued  
at \$5,890,000, being a quantity of 5,176,  
623 bags, while in 1912 the importations  
amounted to 5,722,954 bags, valued  
at about \$6,000,000, and this touched  
the high water mark for flour  
imports at this port. Dealers found  
the flour business in 1913 unprofitable  
because of changing prices, provincial  
currency, disorders and other troubles  
which prevented the moving of stocks  
and the collection of accounts.

**Canada Enters Market.**  
Canada came into the market in  
1913, writes Consul General George E.  
Anderson of Hongkong, for the first  
time in the history of the flour trade  
with about 250,000 bags, improved railway  
facilities making possible the shipment  
to China of some flour which formerly  
sought a market in Europe. Australia  
also sent a quantity of flour, and evi-  
dently looks to that country for a  
future market. Still this competition  
did not affect the exporters of Ameri-  
can flour to the extent of the depre-  
ciated values of the Chinese currency  
in South China.

This year the North China and  
Yanette Valley mills entered into com-  
petition with American flour in South  
China to but a limited extent because  
of the scarce and poor quality of the  
grain supplies. Nevertheless, it is  
reported that the new year opened  
with a fair trade in flour and there  
has been a fair prospect for a steady  
trade if satisfactory conditions can be  
maintained.

**Imports of Oregon Pine.**  
Oregon pine figures to a consider-  
able extent in the Hongkong market,  
the imports for the past year aggregat-  
ing about \$2,000,000. This is used  
mostly for the shipyards and two  
of these took 1,500,000 feet of the Ore-  
gon lumber direct. The trade was  
hampered by high trans-Pacific freight  
rates. Considerable Chinese pine is  
used, and much teakwood from Philip-  
pine hardwoods, which are growing in  
favor for interior finishing. There  
is considerable activity in building,  
which makes a call for lumber, and the  
shipbuilding business is prosperous.

There is noticeable a marked in-  
crease in the trade in foreign food-  
stuffs. Especially is this true in the  
demand among foreign residents and  
also among the better class of Chinese  
for canned fruits and fish, and dried  
fruits, some of the products of Ameri-  
can preserves and preserved fruits, prepared  
meats in various forms, butter, cheese,  
fresh fruits, and in general, the full  
line of fine food products generally  
exported by European and United  
States, and American apples are in  
high favor with the Chinese.

**"Walking Pastor"  
Has New Church**

First Structure for Religious Worship  
Being Completed in Oregon Coast  
Town; Minister Has 90-Mile Hike.

Marshfield, Or., July 2.—There is  
being completed at Gold Beach, a church  
building which is the first church built  
in that place for half a century, the  
town being about 80 years old. In fact,  
it is the only actual church building  
on the coast from Port Orford in  
Oregon, to Smith River, in California,  
a distance of 80 miles. However, these  
conditions will be somewhat changed  
as there is to be a new church at  
Brookings.

The Gold Beach people have not been  
without religious services, but the ex-  
ercises have always been held in some  
other building.  
The pastor in charge of the new  
church is Rev. J. W. Hoyt, a Presby-  
terian minister located in Curry county,  
who acts as missionary for the people  
from Port Orford south to Smith River,  
Cal. Mr. Hoyt probably does more  
walking than any other preacher in the  
country as he always covers the 80  
miles on foot. He holds services at  
Gold Beach, Brookings, Smith River  
and other points and walks from place  
to place. Going on foot affords him  
the opportunity to visit many of the  
farms and to keep in closer touch with  
the people. Recently when Mr. Hoyt  
attended conference he started from  
Gold Beach with a pack on his back to  
walk down the coast to Crescent City  
and eastward from there to Ashland  
to conference, but in this case he was  
offered several lifts by passing autos  
and vehicles.
