ORCHESTRA GOES ALONG

"Lang Syne" Is Name of New Or-

With approximately 150 members of the "Lang Syne" society, and their families, aboard, the steamer Joseph Kellogg swung into the current from the wharf at the foot of Washington street last night shortly before 8 o'clock for the society's first annual excursion. A trip was made down the Columbia and the vessel returned shortly before midnight.

The organization, which was formed six months ago, has for its members only men who were in business in Portland prior to 1891. Its purpose is to give the oldtimers an opportunity to get together periodically and its roster bears the names of many of the prominent people of the city.

As the steamer left the wharf, the orchestra which was carried along to enliven the moonlight hours on the river, struck up "America" and the people floated and sang in unison as they floated down the Willamette.

On the return trip everybody sang "Auld Lang Syne" as the vessel plowed its way toward the dock.

During the evening members of the Apollo club sang selections and a general good time was enjoyed.

According to the plans of those directing the society at least two meetings will be held every year. One will be in the winter, when a banquet will be held, the other in the summer time and a river excursion will be the order of the day.

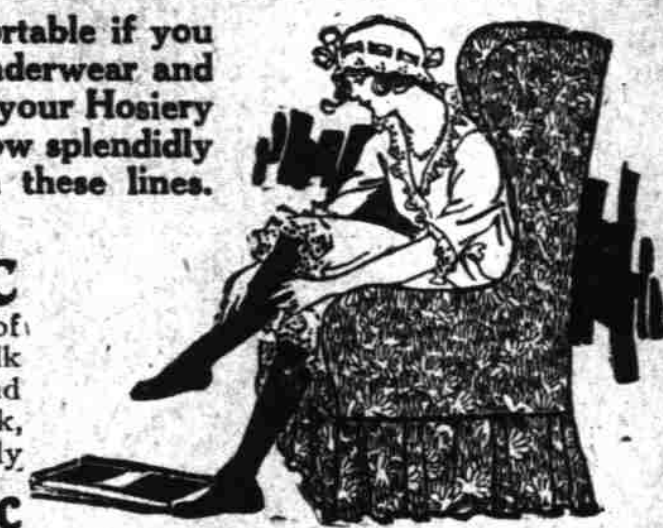
