

BAREHEADED CROWDS STAND AT STATIONS AS TRAIN PASSES BY

Church Bells Told in Every City and Village Along the Route South.

MOURN WITH PRESIDENT

Body of Mrs. Wilson to Be Laid at Rest Beside That of Mother and Father.

Aboard President Wilson's Special Train, Gainesville, Ga., Aug. 11.—The south mourned with President Wilson and his daughters today over the death of Mrs. Woodrow Wilson. Church bells were tolled in every city and village through which the funeral train passed on its way to Rome, Ga.

Crowds stood at each station along the Southern railway, bareheaded and silent. Small groups were gathered even at cross road stations as late as midnight. Flowers were sent aboard the train at Spalding County, Ga., by the committee of citizens. President Wilson remained beside the casket until 1 o'clock this morning. Secret service men maintained the vigil for the remainder of the night. At daylight Mrs. Frances B. Sayre, one of the president's three daughters, appeared and watched beside the body.

The funeral train was scheduled to reach Rome at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon. Services will be held in the First Presbyterian church and Mrs. Wilson's body will then be buried in Myrtle Hill cemetery there, beside those of her mother and father.

Gainesville is the birthplace of Miss Margaret Wilson. More than 15,000 persons met the train here.

Train Arrives at Atlanta

Atlanta, Ga., Aug. 11.—The special train carrying the body of Mrs. Woodrow Wilson, wife of the president, arrived at Rome, Ga., for burial, here this afternoon. It was reported here that all Rome buildings were draped, that all flags were at half mast and that business was suspended.

Dr. Cary Grayson fears the greatest trial for President Wilson and his daughters will be the funeral service in Rome which will be private, the Rev. G. G. Snyder officiating.

Visit to Stockyards Will Bring Credits

Teachers Attending County Institute to Have Option of Going Through Plant—Saving in Salaries Expected.

Credit will be given teachers who attend the annual teachers' institute for Multnomah county if they take advantage of arrangements made by County School Superintendent Armstrong and visit the Portland Union stock yards one half day during the institute. The visit will be optional. The institute will be held at the central library, September 8, 9 and 10. Evening sessions will be held during the institute to enable teachers who do not take the trip to the stockyards to make up the hours of attendance. By holding the institute before school opens, Superintendent Armstrong expects to save over \$2000 in salaries of teachers who attend.

MARKS INDICATE MURDER

Called to Troutdale to investigate the death of an unknown man whose body was found about two miles from Troutdale in the woods, Sheriff Wood telephoned that he is under the impression that the man was murdered. He gave no details as to marks on the body and said that nothing was left which would identify the body. The body will be removed where the coroner has arrived. It will be necessary to carry it about a mile and a half to reach the road. The man had been dead, he said, about five days.

Wants People to Sing

A "sing" in connection with the municipal band concert at Laurelhurst park next Sunday is the innovation announced today by Commissioner W. L. Brewster. "We think the people will enjoy the concert more if they help themselves," said Commissioner Brewster. The singing will be led by W. M. Wilder. Wife Charges Desertion

The plaintiff alleged that the defendant deserted her November 18, 1891, and she alleged Miller left in September, 1911. They have four children, three of age or nearly so and one eight years old. She asks for the custody of that child, \$500 alimony and \$40 a month for the support of herself and child.

WAR RISK INSURANCE SCHEME OF BRITAIN OUTLINED TO SHIPPERS

Goods Protected Must Be Carried in English Bottoms Says Message From N. Y.

Of great interest to local shippers is the copy of a cablegram received in New York yesterday which has been sent broadcast by the New York Chamber of Commerce, defining the conditions of the war risk scheme evolved by the British government for protecting goods sent from this country abroad. The chief stipulation of the plan is that cargoes must be sent in British bottoms.

The following message from Sereno S. Pratt, secretary of the New York Chamber of Commerce, was received by the Portland Chamber of Commerce: "New York, Aug. 10.—The following cablegram from Percy Chubb was reported to the special committee on problems of war shipments of the New York chamber of commerce at its meeting today. It is important that it should be widely published:

"London, Aug. 10.—Government insurance is limited to goods carried on vessels of British registry which have been insured. Under government war risk scheme application must be made to war risk office, London, either by personal representation or through London broker. Provisional value must be stated and payment of premium then required. No claims will be paid by British vessels which have been insured. Return premium will be made and losses settled on basis of value covered by ordinary marine insurance.

In order to comply with these conditions, cargo must be covered by marine insurance, either with Lloyd's, British insurance companies or approved companies or underwriters, so as to prove value in case of loss. Only sailings or callings subsequent to August 4 acceptable, provided voyages approved. There are some restricted cargo only certificates from day to day at London office. At present there are very few. Cannot cable details of them. Scheme contemplates covering all voyages except to enemy's country. Undertaking no question of contraband will be considered as to cargo destined for English or allies' ports. Ownership of cargo immaterial, barring enemy's. Understand all reputable English or American companies would be considered and approved and their evidence as to insured value will be accepted. Rate same for all. Any voyage now four guineas."

EUROPEAN WAR TO BRING BEST KIND OF TIMES, SAYS BANKER

This Country Has Everything and People Overseas Have Got to Buy From Us.

PRICES ARE ALL HIGH, TOO

America's Decks Cleared to Take Advantage of Present Situation—Reserve Bank Approved.

Believing that the American people stand before one of the greatest periods of substantial prosperity in their history, A. M. Crawford, vice president of the Lumbermen's National bank, declares that optimism, not pessimism, should govern them in view of the war situation in Europe.

"I do not believe that this general European war is going to hurt the United States," he said this morning. "On the contrary, I believe it is going to usher in one of the greatest eras of real good times we have ever experienced—not boom times, but solid prosperity.

"Our decks are cleared to take advantage of the situation. We are in better shape than any other country on the globe. The currency bill has put into effect an adequate federal reserve system, the railroads have been granted their increase in rates, we have adjusted ourselves to the tariff, everybody knows what the anti-trust legislation will be like, we have the greatest crops in our history. The atmosphere is cleared; this war has come like a rain and takes all the dust out of the air. Why should not America prosper?"

This Country in Fine Shape

"The continent wants our wheat; we have it to sell. Look at the price of wheat, of wool, of barley, and then ask why anyone in this country should be downcast. The boom times of a few years back were artificial, based on speculation in corner lots. The business depression of last year was due largely to a reaction and to universal gloom, for there is a good deal in this psychological business depression.

Griffen to Face Larceny Charge

O. F. Hagan Alleges That Lawyer Has Failed to Account for \$1000 Placed With Him for Investment.

On a complaint filed several weeks ago, Attorney E. B. Griffen surrendered to arrest yesterday afternoon and put up \$2000 cash bail for his appearance to answer a charge of larceny by bailment. Griffen is alleged by O. F. Hagan to have received \$1000 December 15, 1911, for use for Hagan's benefit and to have failed to account for the money.

Attorney M. R. Klepper, who represents Hagan, said that Griffen was given the money to invest in first mortgage securities. He said that instead Griffen purchased a lot from Sadie Clinkett which was mortgaged for \$3000. The property was deeded to Griffen, he said, and Griffen gave Hagan a second mortgage. When the mortgages were foreclosed the property brought only enough to pay the first mortgage, with the result that Griffen was left with nothing to show for his money. Klepper said that in a civil suit over the property, Judge Morrow held Griffen responsible for the money.

TEACHERS FIRST IN CONSIDERATION FOR RETURN FROM EUROPE

Government Aims to Get Pedagogues Back in Time for Opening of Fall Term.

(United Press Leased Wire.)

Washington, Aug. 11.—American travelers in Europe of moderate means will be provided with passage home first, according to Secretary of War Garrison.

"The problem of getting teachers back in time to open the schools will be given first consideration," he said. "Teachers' larger means will be asked to wait."

Secretary Garrison was optimistic over the situation today, saying everything possible was being done for Americans in Europe.

Foodstuffs Advance By Leaps, Bounds

Patent Flour Up 20 Cents a Barrel and Sugar Climbs 50 Cents Per Hundred Pounds; Due to War.

Further sharp advances in the price of foodstuffs are shown in the Portland market. Some of them are direct results of the European war, while others have been indirectly forced by the foreign troubles.

The price of patent flour advanced 20 cents a barrel both here and on Puget Sound today. Wheat indirectly is due to the European troubles which have caused higher prices for wheat throughout the world, directly the advance has been forced by the speculative activity of Pacific northwest grain buyers.

Sugar prices are leaping skyward. Late yesterday afternoon there was an advance of 50 cents per 100 pounds in addition to the rise of 25 cents made earlier in the day. Still further advances are anticipated.

Most prices are advancing generally in other markets and a rise in nearly all lines is expected here soon.

Italy Is Expected

William of Wied in Rome Straits and French Soldiers Will Soon Have to Be Withdrawn.

Athens, Aug. 11.—Seizure of Albania by Italy was anticipated here today. The situation at Durazzo, the capital, where William of Wied, the so-called king, retained a precarious foothold, were described as desperate. It was said William's troops were unpaid and his treasury was empty. Practically only the French were left in Albania and French detachments landed when his people rebelled against him and declared their independence.

PETER OF SERBIA AS BLOODY AS HUERTA, SAY SALEM GERMANS

Statement Intended to Correct Believed Misunderstanding as to Conditions.

TEUTONS VERSUS SLAVS

Two Nations Fighting for National Honor and for Their Very Existence.

(Salem Bureau of The Journal.) Salem, Or., Aug. 11.—The German society of Salem, indignant over what it believes to be an evident misunderstanding of the situation in Europe, has issued the following statement, prepared by Colonel E. Hofer and Dr. G. A. Winkelnus. The statement is as follows:

"To understand the European war situation it must be remembered that for at least 500 years the Teutonic race has resisted with armed force the invasion of Europe by Slavs, Tartars and Turks.

"The narrative of their struggles to keep these elements out of civilized Christendom constitutes modern and medieval history.

"In the present war at least 80,000,000 of German speaking peoples are arrayed against the Slav nation, called Serbia, supported by the Russian nation, Slav and Tartar, and indirectly supported by Roumania, Bulgaria and Montenegro.

"Serbia, the direct cause of the present war, is at best a half civilized nation with a king called Peter. Peter was the head of the military cabal responsible for the assassination of the Austrian crown prince, Ferdinand, and his wife, Alexander, his predecessor.
