Are your teeth good chewers? "Some men and women have never chewed anything in their lives," said a local orthodontist when asked about the peculiar irregularities that often occur in teeth.

Perhaps not one person in 25 knows, while this branch of dentistry has been practiced for a number of years, that the word is comparatively so new that it has no entry in any encyclopedias nor in some unabridged dictionaries.
