

LATE POTATO CROP OF THE NORTHWEST IS A RATHER HEAVY ONE COUNTY CLERK HAS COMPLETED COUNT OF VOTES ON CANDIDATES

TURKEY MARKET VERY SLUGGISH BUT AS YET NO SURPLUS SHOWN Receipts Have Been Practically Cleaned Up to Date at Lower Prices Than Expected; Big Movement Due Here Sunday.

The market for turkeys is very sluggish along the coast and a similar report is coming from other marketing centers along the coast. During the last 24 hours sales of dressed turkeys were rather slow at 19.20c for the best, although a handful of fancy stuff was sold at 20c above this. Some cut birds sold at the same time down to 17c a pound and receipts were glad to unload.

Heavy receipts of turkeys are due in the local trade tomorrow and Monday. As a rule, the bulk of the shipments arrive the Sunday previous to Thanksgiving and this season is expected to be no exception to the rule. While the receipts of turkeys have been quite liberal this week and prices have been somewhat lower than expected, still the bulk of the arrivals were sold and the trade is quite well cleaned up and awaiting the big movement.

It is generally believed that profits in turkeys will wait until the last minute to secure their needs. CRAB SUPPLY VERY SCARCE Great scarcity of crabs is shown in the local market. An advice from Bay County, Wash., was to the effect that crab fishermen there would probably go on a strike for higher prices.

EGG MARKET HOLDS FIRMER Firmer tone is showing for eggs in the local market and sales are again being made at higher prices than selected stock. The buying at this time seems to be especially for the holiday trade. Receipts light.

CHICKEN MARKET IS BETTER Better tone is again showing for chickens in the Front street market. Sales during the last 24 hours were generally at 13.75c a pound with heavy hens as high as 15c. Receipts are rather limited.

CHEESE MARKET IS FIRMER Market for cheese is again firmer generally along the coast and a further advance in the price is generally expected by the local trade. Butter market continues to show strength at former prices.

LOCAL PRODUCE IS GAINING Kipped salmon from Astoria is fast driving the inferior product of Eugene south from the local territory and business is likewise said to be increasing in California. The local shipped product is made from salmon only.

OLD HOP BUSINESS SHOWN While there is a small amount of hop business shown at this time, reports in a morning paper are said by the trade to be somewhat misleading. Harry L. Hart purchased the Muecke lot of 24 carloads of hops at a price reported around 9c.
