

FRENCH DESTROYING GERMAN VILLAGES, IS CHARGED AT BERLIN

Statement Says French Artillery Fire Is Wantonly Ruining Villages.

50 CHASSEURS CAPTURED

Several Trenches in the Argonne Taken, It Is Claimed; While Germans Advance on Vistula.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Berlin, via wireless to London, Jan. 7.—Fresh charges were made yesterday by the war office that the French are wantonly destroying German villages behind the Kaiser's lines. These placid, it was asserted, are being systematically wrecked by heavy bombardments which do no harm whatever to the Teutonic troops.

The capture of several trenches, with two officers and 500 men, was claimed in the Argonne, near Sedan. The French, it was said, did actually make some progress on the Senneheim heights, in Alsace, but were later repulsed by a bayonet charge. The capture in this district was reported of 50 French mountain chassours.

In the eastern theatre of war, it was stated, the Germans had advanced on the Vistula as far as the Sucha branch, capturing several Russian positions, nine machine guns and 1400 prisoners. That the capture by the German forces in Poland of the town of Borjow offers them an opportunity to drive a wedge into the Russians' center, compelling the Slavs to retire to their secondary line of defenses or to meet a flank attack, was the opinion of military experts here today. First line German troops were reported to be advancing on Cracow.

On the whole the situation in Poland was deemed very favorable, from the Kaiser's standpoint.

Chain of 15 Cent Hotels Is Planned

Success of Dawes Hotel in Chicago Prompts Association to Consider Building Three More Soon.

Chicago, Jan. 7.—Plans were under way here today to establish a chain of 15 cent hotels throughout the country by the Rufus F. Dawes Hotel association. Money for these hotels already has been subscribed and Seattle, Minneapolis and New York have been suggested as probable locations.

The decision to build a string of hotels outside of Chicago was reached following the publication of a financial statement by the Dawes Hotel here, erected by Charles G. Dawes as a memorial to his son. The statement showed that 178,000 men were housed during 1914 and that all of the 511 beds in the hotel were taken nightly.

Fifty-nine thousand meals were served during the year at the following rates: Coffee, 2c; milk, 1c; meat, 3c; beans, 3c; mutton and bread, 3c; soup, 2c; pie, 3c. The bed rates were five cents each for beds in wards and 10 cents for beds in private rooms. The hotel, the statement said, lost only \$439.81 on beds during the year. The management figures that a chain of hotels charging 15 cents for beds will not only be profitable, but will be a boon to the investment.

Charter Big Issue In Medford Election

City Manager With Commission of Seven Who Have Power to Remove Him, Is Provided.

Parliament in the city election to be held at Medford, Or., January 12, is the question of whether or not the proposed new city charter shall be adopted. The proposed form of government is the work of a commission of 21 citizens, and a great deal of interest has been aroused over the coming vote.

Should the measure be adopted, Medford will be ruled by an advisory board of seven commissioners elected by the people. They will have the power to work under them who will attend to all details of government. He will be subject to removal at any time the commission may see fit. Model accounting and reporting methods are provided, and a strict account of every bit of city property is provided for.

Wants Laws Harmonized.

District Attorney Evans was requested yesterday by the county commissioners to act for the board in preparing such amendments as are necessary to make the interstate bridge law more harmonious and to make it harmonize with the Washington law. The Clarke county commissioners appointed a committee of five for the same purpose with regard to the Washington laws.
