Today's Forecast.

Weather Conditions.

Another depression which threatened last night to cause high winds and rain, has separated into two disturbances and the danger of very high winds has in consequence been greatly lessened.

A large high pressure area over the Pacific slope on the Pacific coast as far south as San Francisco and snow has occurred in portions of Minnesota and northern Wisconsin. It is much warmer in eastern Montana and the western portion of the Dakotas than correspondingly colder in the Atlantic states.

The conditions are favorable for unsettled weather in this section, with rain and snow with rain in western Oregon and western Washington and rain or snow elsewhere.
