

**THIS SESSION MUST STRAIGHTEN KINKS IN COLUMBIA SPAN ACT**

Tolls Provided but No One Is Authorized to Collect; Operating Body in Doubt.

Salem, Or., Jan. 21.—Legislation will have to be enacted by this legislature to straighten out ambiguities and cover omissions in the law enacted two years ago in relation to the construction of the interstate bridge between Portland and Vancouver.

This was done at the first meeting of the Multnomah delegation yesterday afternoon. Chairman E. V. Littlefield, of the delegation, appointed Senator Moser as representative of Multnomah as a committee to confer with District Attorney Walter H. Evans of Multnomah and prepare a bill to provide for the collection and disposition of tolls.

While the law of two years ago provided that the structure may be conducted as a toll bridge, no provision was made as to who should collect the tolls or what should be done with the money this collected.

Clyde B. Aitchison, member of the railroad commission, pointed out the conflict in authority over the bridge as conferred by the two laws enacted by the last legislature. These are chapters 145 and 279 of the 1913 session laws. One chapter gives a commission consisting of the governor and the county commissioners authority to construct, maintain and provide for the operation of the bridge, while the other chapter says, after the bridge is completed it shall be under the control of the state railroad commission.

Mr. Aitchison presented an amendment to the law to place the entire control of the bridge in the hands of the governor and the county commission. He explained that the railroad commission had no objection to taking control of the bridge, but if it did so it was not proper for the other commission to make all the contracts and arrangements for the operation of the bridge.

He pointed out that the law is state-wide in its application and that Umatilla, Malheur, or some other county on the border might want to construct an interstate bridge under the provisions, and as they are considerable distance from the seat of the railroad commission he thought it would be better perhaps to place the control of the bridge in the hands of the governor and the county commission.

Senator Moser said he feared there would be opposition to the measure from members from other counties since the state is obligated to pay the interest on the interstate bridge bonds.

**One Day of Rest In Every Seven**

Employer Must Designate Which of His Employees Shall Have Holidays in Week Days.

Salem, Or., Jan. 21.—Private prosecutors stand a gambler's chance of earning a \$25 fee in paying to court violations of a proposed law introduced in the house yesterday by Representative Horne. The bill prohibits county making it unlawful for any employer to work his employees more than six days a week.

The bill prescribes that every employer of labor shall designate which of his employees shall have their holidays on certain week days, in cases where Sunday work is required and shall post such lists, also filing a copy with the commissioner of labor.

Exceptions to the "one day of rest in seven" idea are made only in the cases of bakery workers who set sponge and watchmen and furnace tenders.

Breaking this proposed law is punishable by a moderate fine for the first offense and a fine and imprisonment for the second. The private prosecutor is allowed to bring information before justices of the peace, first putting up security for costs.

If the court finds the defendant not guilty, the prosecutor must pay the costs. If he is found guilty, the prosecutor is allowed an attorney fee of at least \$25.

**Economy Inspires Committee Action**

Representative Olson Says Move to Abolish Office of Immigration Agent No Reflection on Chapman.

Salem, Or., Jan. 21.—When Conrad P. Olson of Multnomah county moved the passage of the bill abolishing the office of state immigration agent, yesterday, he took occasion to make it plain to the house that the recommendation of the judiciary committee was in no way a reflection upon the work of C. C. Chapman, immigration agent, or that it believed that there is no need for the exploitation of Oregon.

"This is an economical session and we have to trim somewhere," he said. "Mr. Chapman makes an extremely good plea for the continuance of the department, and I doubt not that the Oregon Development league, which matches dollar for dollar the legislative appropriation, will be much disappointed under present circumstances."

Twelve bills were introduced yesterday afternoon, and the house adjourned, its members scattering at once into a score of committee meetings.
