

PORTLAND WOMAN INVENTS COLLAPSIBLE TABLE FOR CAMPERS

Mrs. M. Cavatine, Removes Necessity of Spreading Dinner on Ground.

CONTRIVANCE PATENTED

When Taken Down, Table Folds Like a Pocket Knife and May Be Easily Carried.

Mrs. M. Cavatine, who conducts a boarding house at 452 Morrison street, is an inventor. She has visions of wealth as a result. Her invention is a collapsible table which she claims is ideal for campers, picnickers, or for use in sample rooms.

For some time she has had such a table for her own use when out camping or for a picnic dinner. Requests from many of her friends for a similar table gave her the idea of having it patented and manufactured in commercial lots.

The top of the table is made of four very thin, light boards, each board being held in place by four corner bolts together. The table legs and supporting framework are light, but apparently strong. When the table is taken down it folds like a jack-knife. When taken down the table fits into a bag easily carried under one's arm. The weight of the table is about eight pounds.

Under a royalty contract the table is being manufactured by the Oregon Woodenware Manufacturing company, of Portland.

Reported Hair Must Work for His Living

Thomas Bell, Farmland Who Is Said to Have Inherited Part of \$3,000,000, Refused to Get Excited.

"I have to work for a living," said Thomas Bell, the farmland who is reported to be one of the heirs to a \$3,000,000 estate, yesterday at the James Fitzgerald farm at Paterson, Bell, who lives alone in a cabin on the edge of Blue lake, a mile and a half northwest of Fairview, on James Fitzgerald's property, is going calmly on about his business with occasional labor for Fitzgerald and other farmers of the district.

Bell made a trip to Portland a few days ago to seek further information about his supposed good fortune from a Portland law firm, but has not announced the result of his investigation. It was reported that Bell's uncle, John K. Bell, a commission merchant, died recently in Manchester, England, leaving a \$3,000,000 estate, which it was believed would fall to Thomas Bell and his two cousins, Harry and James Bell, of Yorkshire. It was later reported that other claimants to the estate have been given the persons of three half-brothers of Tom, Fred Bell, living at the Ryecroft hotel, and two other claimants: Lester Bell, of Centralia, Wash., and Brenton Bell, who appeared in Portland several months ago on the Pantages circuit.

Leaves Business to Faithful Employees

Pennsylvania Clothing Merchant Rewards in Will Men Who Helped Him Build up His Fortune.

Allentown, Pa., March 20.—Liberal treatment of the employees who helped him build up his business is the outstanding feature of the will of Thomas Koch, clothing merchant and banker, who died February 11, leaving an estate valued at nearly \$1,000,000. Six employees are named as beneficiaries and are to succeed to his business, and ten years are given to them in which to buy his store, valued at \$250,000, at \$100,000, and his real estate, valued at \$500,000, at \$250,000. These employees are William J. Schaefer, Harry Jordan, and John Ritter, who are each to have four-sixteenths; Samuel Kuhns, two-sixteenths, and Edward Kuhns and Samuel Ritter, one-sixteenth each.

A surprise awaited some of the men. The will contained instructions where to find a private ledger in which he had set down various sums opposite their names as bonuses for services well and faithfully performed, and these sums were to be credited as payments of their shares in the business. He further provided that if any of them would not accept the provisions of his will, they or their estates should receive in cash the amounts he had thus credited to them.
