

KINDERGARTENS ARE URGED AS MEANS OF MORAL REDEMPTION

Mothers' Congress Speaker Declares Race Still on Lowest Round of Ladder.

EVIL COULD BE OVERCOME

Worst Villain at One Time Could Have Had Evil Propensities Directed Into Useful Channel.

"Kindergartens for Oregon" was the slogan of this afternoon's session of the National Congress of Mothers, and the principal address was given by Miss Beadle Locke of the United States bureau of education and National Kindergarten association. She said:

"It has been said that physically man will evolve no more than morally and spiritually he is at the very first round of the ladder. We are forced reluctantly to admit that our boasted civilization seems but a veneer when we contemplate the overwhelming evidences of ignorance, dishonesty and immorality with which we come in daily contact. "Men are but children of a larger growth and there is a time in the life of even the vilest villain when his propensity for evil could have been overcome and all his perverted energies directed into useful channels. The reformatories and jails are crowded and prisons are filled with the children of yesterday who never had a chance to rise above the miserable conditions into which they were born. "An important question is, how can we hasten the time when the vast multitude of these little children, who are coming into the world every day may be gently led out of the environment of ignorance and crime into the bright light of a useful and happy existence.

Explanation Not Necessary.

"It is not necessary for me to explain what the kindergarten does for the little child, though I could quote superintendents of public schools and grade teachers infinitely to demonstrate from the experience of our American educators that kindergartens have proven their value beyond all question.

"All people of average intelligence who understand the system appreciate its importance and realize that it is one of the most rapid, quickest and very best means possible for promoting the welfare of the people of any community and for the general uplift of the human race.

Kindergartens' Importance Urged. "In some parts of the country kindergartens have been adopted in a large proportion of the cities and towns, but there are still more than three and a half million children for whom kindergartens have not been provided and, according to the latest census, 29,000 of these children are in Oregon, the only state in the Union which has not public school kindergartens.

"There is no part of the United States where there is larger generosity in the department of education than in this great progressive west. The enthusiasm and brought the finest spirit of the world to settle here and you should be alert to the importance of the kindergarten as the chief factor in the formation and development of the character of the children in your land.

"Your colleges are among the best, but how few of your children will reach them; the earlier and more important steps of childish education lag. The awakening has commenced. California passed a law in 1913 providing for kindergartens upon petition of parents. The law was prepared by Mrs. Rowell, present of the California Congress of Mothers, and has proved effective.

Many Opened This Year. "As a result kindergartens have been opened this year in 13 cities in that state and more are to be opened, and 52 new kindergartens have been established. Nevada has just passed a similar law. It has been suggested that boards of education would probably establish kindergartens upon petition of parents without special legislation, so I have brought with me some blank petitions and suggest that everyone living near public schools needing a kindergarten, will present a petition signed by the parents or guardians of 25 children and work for its favorable consideration. If this method is not effective, I suggest you work for a law like that in California and Nevada, the next time your legislature convenes. "It seems reasonable to believe that in so up-to-date a community this great salutary propaganda must receive your hearty indorsement. Your earnest assistance in the advancement of the kindergarten movement, to establish classes wherever it is possible to do so, is urged as the one quick and sure means of conferring upon the children of this land a legacy of perpetual prosperity and happiness while assuring it to the greatest possible extent against ignorance, dishonesty and crime."

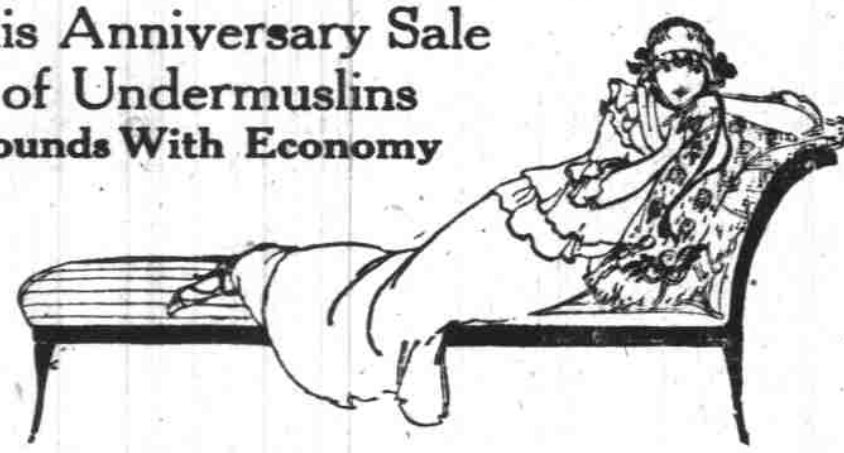
