

SIX OUT OF NINE GO TO BEAVERS IN FOUST WITH SEAL LEADERS

Champions Break Even on Sunday Games When Kahler Wins in Afternoon.

STUMPF GETS 4 WALLOPS

His Second Base Man Helps in Post-prandial Victory; Beavers and Oaks on Their Way North.

San Francisco, Cal., June 28.—With a record of six games out of nine tucked away, the Beavers are speeding northward to Portland to open up a series Tuesday with the Oakland club. It has been a great little week for the Beavers, and they surely did the league a service by pulling the Seals down a notch. The race is the greatest ever staged in the minor leagues, with only 73 points separating the Seals, in first place, and the Venice club, in last place.

Spider Baum was in good form yesterday, and gave the Seals an even break on the day's duty. Big George Kahler pitched in the afternoon, and off six hits, while the Beavers gathered four runs off 11 bingles.

Krause started badly in the morning, when three runs went over the fence in the first inning. Doane batted for Krause in the eighth, and Higginbotham pitched the last inning, getting walloped for eight runs and two hits.

Baum allowed three tallies in the first game, and were made in the sixth. Cloutier, second base, followed with a single past third that scored Derrick. Hilliard was a pop out and Fisher, third base, came across with a double that cleared the bags.

In the afternoon the game was signalled by four clean hits by second base Stumpf of the Beavers, three singles and a double in five times up. Schaller's triple and Bodie's fly gave the Seals their third run. Hilliard evened it in the second on Hilliard's single, the beating of Speas, and two outs.

Brown scored for the Seals in the third on his single, a sacrifice and Schaller's hit. Melan's homer in the fourth completed the scoring for the locals.

Portland made two in the sixth, tying the count. Stumpf and Bates scored after the bases had been filled on two infield outs.

Carish's single in the eighth won the game, this being followed by Lohr's long hit.

RACING DRIVER KILLED TRYING TO PASS RIVAL

Clarence King Dead and His Mechanician, Leslie Puett, Seriously Injured.

Sacramento, Cal., June 28.—(U. P.) Clarence O. King, veteran driver, was instantly killed and his brother-in-law, Leslie Puett, was probably fatally injured, when their Maxwell racer went through the fence and turned turtle in the first lap of the light car race at the state fair grounds Sunday.

King was traveling at the rate of 70 miles an hour when his car crashed through the fence as he tried to pass Frank Wiesmayer, driving an Overland, at the half mile turn.

King's wife and father, Charles M. King, were in the grandstand, and saw the car plunge into the ditch and turn over twice, pinning the racers under it.

Puett's skull was fractured and at the White hospital it was announced today there is little hope for his recovery.

King was well known in automobile racing circles, and had competed against Barney Oldfield, the speed king. He came to Sacramento several years ago, and took up the Maxwell agency, which he bought chicken ranch on the Stockton road, and has been living there since.

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
