

PACIFIC LIVESTOCK CASE HAS ATTENTION OF ATTORNEY BROWN

Question Arises as to Whether or Not He May Be Hampered in Action.

THE MONEY WAS VOTED

Impression Originally That There Were No Strings to Appropriation for Expenses.

Salem, Or., June 29.—Whether Attorney General Brown will be hampered in an investigation of the case of the state against the Pacific Livestock company, known also as the Harney county case, in which it is attempted to recover title to 20,000 acres of land, alleged to have been obtained fraudulently, is a question that is causing some speculation at the capitol.

Attorney General Brown is now engaged in an investigation to ascertain if there is sufficient evidence to warrant continuing the prosecution of the case, which was instituted by Attorney General Crawford, Brown's predecessor.

The general impression after the session of the legislature was that there were no strings to the \$10,000 appropriated for the attorney general to prosecute certain cases, inasmuch as the appropriation bill imposed no conditions, but lately it has developed that Brown entered into an agreement with the appropriations committee to use the fund in the Pacific Livestock company's case and other cases only if the state land board should consider it advisable to do so.

The agreement is of no effect in a legal sense, it is contended, and it is believed that in case Attorney General Brown finds that he has a good chance to recover the title to the state he will continue the prosecution, even if the board should decide that they should be dismissed.

The section of the law providing for the payment of cost of special litigation follows:

"For the payment of the expenses of litigation and contingent expenses connected therewith, accruing in civil cases where not otherwise provided for, and including the estimated expenses of witnesses, court costs, traveling, procuring evidence and expenses of every kind in the prosecution of Hyde-Benson cases, and in the prosecution of the litigation arising out of land frauds in Harney and Grant counties, \$10,000."

Attorney General Brown was not anxious to discuss the case, although he admitted that one member of the state land board had intimated to him that the board might decide to not let him spend any of the \$10,000 fund in the case against the Pacific Livestock company. He would not say which one of the three members of the board, which consists of Governor Withycombe, State Treasurer Kay and

Secretary of State Olcott, made the statement.

Brown said he had drawn on the \$10,000 fund for expenses in making a trip to Washington, D. C., and, while there and at points on the way, investigated the Pacific Livestock case.

Shortly after the session of the legislature, the state land board held a meeting, with all members present, and State Treasurer Kay represented that Attorney General Brown wanted the case against the livestock company dismissed, stating that he would never have brought it in the first place, on the evidence.

Secretary of State Olcott said that was his understanding of Brown's attitude and then Kay urged Governor Withycombe to dismiss the suit, arguing that inasmuch as Governor West had brought the suit it would be as well for Governor Withycombe to take action dismissing it.

Entire Board Votes.

Governor Withycombe declined to take the responsibility and declared that the whole board would have to vote on the proposition. A vote was taken and all three members voted in favor of dismissing the suit.

Attorney General Brown learned a few minutes later what had been done and hurried over to Governor Withycombe's office, where he entered a strong protest, declaring that he had not had time to investigate the case fully and did not know enough about it to warrant a recommendation for its dismissal.

Thereupon Governor Withycombe declared that the meeting just held was merely informal and of no effect, and that Brown should continue his investigation of the suit and report in due time if there was evidence sufficient to warrant its continuance.

He is still engaged in making this investigation.

17TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE EPISCOPATE OF ARCHBISHOP CHRISTIE
