

## SALOONKEEPER SHOT RESISTING ROBBER IN ATTEMPTED HOLD-UP

John Hamilton, Proprietor,  
Replies With Revolver to  
Intruder's Orders.

## THIEF EMPTIES HIS GUN

Successful Escape Made, but No Loot  
Secured; Saloonman Not Dan-  
gerously Injured.

Resisting the attack of a masked robber who attempted to hold up his saloon at 12:55 this morning, John Hamilton, proprietor of the barroom at 312 North Twenty-first street, was shot through both legs in the course of a terrific gun fight.

Hamilton, who lives at 931 Irving street, was just closing his saloon when the robber entered. The man was masked with a white handkerchief, and carried a small caliber revolver. Hamilton was taking the money from his cash register at the time. Ben McWilliams of the Great Northern hotel and Arthur Johnson of 523 North Twenty-second street were seated at a table near the front of the room.

"Hands up," was the only order or word spoken by the front door during the time he was in the saloon.

The two patrons of the place complied with the order, but Hamilton grabbed his gun from under the bar and began shooting.

As he did so he stepped around the end of the bar. The robber replied to the fire, emptying his gun. The bullet shattered glasses and the bar. From the position of the wounds on Hamilton's legs, it is believed both were caused by the same bullet.

After Hamilton dropped, he fired two more shots, both wild. After the unwelcome visitor exhausted his fire-arm, he ran out the front door, making no attempt to take the money.

Hamilton was taken to the Good Samaritan hospital in a police automobile by Patrolman L. F. Russell, where his injuries were found to be not serious. Detectives Craddock and Hellyer and Sergeant Oelner and Patrolmen Hutch, Tully, Johnston and Morris spent the rest of the night searching for the robber, but without success.

## Annual Missionary Meeting Is Held

Hoge represented missionary work among the foreigners at Ellis island and was presided over by Miss Columbus who tendered a well-coming hand to women of the church dressed in the native costumes of Armenia, Holland, Norway, Italy and of the Slovak people.

Real Turkish coffee was served at a Turkish booth in charge of Mrs. A. C. Moses.

Representing work among the negroes of the south was a plantation cabin in charge of Mrs. W. C. Kantner from which hoe cake was served.

China and Japan were represented in a booth filled with curios and handicraft from these nations, loaned from private collections in Portland. Mrs. E. R. Dyott was in charge.

India, with Mrs. Robert Millard in charge, was filled with young women dressed in Hindu costume who sold fruit.

At the elections held during yesterday's business session Mrs. Belle T. Hoge was re-elected president of the foreign missionary branch for Oregon, and Mrs. W. C. Kantner re-elected president of the home missionary board.
