

FINE TRAIN TO HAUL
PENNSYLVANIA PARTY
HERE ON LABOR DAY

Governor Brumbaugh and
Friends Will Be Given a
Royal Reception.

LOCAL CLUB IS ACTIVE

**Railroad Company Provides Travelers
With Most Elaborate Equip-
ment Available**

Governor Martin G. Brumbaugh of Pennsylvania, accompanied by more than 100 distinguished Pennsylvanians, will arrive in San Francisco tomorrow and after remaining there for a week will come to Portland. Elaborate plans have been made by the Pennsylvania club of this city to welcome him on Labor Day, September 6. Charles J. Schnabel, president of the Pennsylvania club, has gone to San Francisco to escort the party to Oregon.

The train in which Governor Brumbaugh left his home today morning is said to be the finest special train ever sent out by the Pennsylvania railroad. Western railroad men are waiting to view it, and it is expected that the treatment and accommodations it outranks anything ever seen on the Pacific coast.

All Steel Throughout.

The train is all steel and consists of one 74-foot baggage car, one combined car, two of the new specially designed Pennsylvania dining cars, seat dining cars, the largest dining cars in operation on any railroad, five sleeping cars and a drawing room observation car.

The observation car, in addition to the usual equipment, will also be supplied with a Steinway player grand piano, and a billiard table. The appointments the train is remarkable, and there will be velvet covered chairs between all cars to prevent the passengers from getting their hands or feet soiled in going from car to car.
