Quality of Oregon Hop Crop Better Than Expected

Latest Reports Indicate Quantity and Quality Good; Trading Is in a Very Limited Way.

Quality of the top crop of Oregon is somewhat better than had been generally expected. While there is considerable hop to be had, it is not as good as the crop of last year.
