

Big Exposition Has Earned \$1,400,000

San Francisco, Nov. 5.—(P. N. S.)—A total of \$1,400,000 has been earned by the Panama-Pacific exposition up to and including the last day of October, according to a preliminary report of the ninth four week period given last night by Rodney S. Durkee, controller of the exposition.

Although the complete figures of the period are not yet ready, it is estimated that the earnings for the last four week period total \$660,000 with operating expenses amounting to \$510,000, leaving a net profit of \$150,000. The exposition has put away \$530,000 in a special sinking fund.

The decrease in the net profits of this period over that of the preceding is accounted for by the added expenses due to the horse show and livestock exhibition, both of which necessitated an expenditure of large sums for prizes.
