POULTRY MARKET A MASS OF STRENGTH AS ALL CLEANED UP

Only a Handful of Stuff on the Street After the Holiday and These Arrivals Were Late; Outlook Is Very Good.

The entire poultry market is in excellent shape along Front street after the holiday and with another holiday only a few days left the outlook for values is rather good.

Practically the entire poultry market was cleaned up of the holding for the Christmas trade. While there are a few dozen turkeys left on the street, most of these are in the hands of the dealers.

EGGS STILL ACCUMULATING While general values are showing no change along the street, the market for fresh eggs is weaker, with stocks accumulating.

ORANGES ARE CHEAPER AGAIN Further reduction is shown in the price of large sized oranges, but the small sizes are unchanged, as high as \$3.25, and celery limited.

CELERY PRICE IS REDUCED Front street celery is now quoting all sizes of California celery at \$3.75 a crate, or 25¢ under winter, but trade is slow for this inferior quality.

DRESSED MEATS HOLD FIRM All through the market for country killed meats, a firmer tone is showing along Front street. Values are generally quoted at 15¢ per cwt. for tip-top quality, but trade is slow for this inferior quality.

SMALL SUPPLIES OF SMELT A very small supply of Columbia river smelt was offering in the trade at 20¢ a pound. Receipts of no called smelt salmon from Puget sound were better, but trade is slow for this inferior quality.

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WHEAT MARKET HAS STRUCK HIGH MARK; BIDDING IS VERY KEEN

Buyers Show More Disposition to Take Grain Than When Values Were Lower; Interior Is Aided by New Freight Rate to Come.

Higher prices have again been forced for wheat at practically all American centers. As high as \$1.05 per bushel, bid wheat track basis, has been paid recently for bluestem and Turkey red in the interior of the Pacific northwest. This establishes a new high record for the present movement and means a total advance of 25¢ a bushel since the season started.

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Stock Market Gets Good Rise; Lack Of Bearish News

New York, Dec. 27. (U. P.) - The absence of untoward occurrences over the holidays stimulated the market to a strong opening today, with nearly the entire list of securities up to or over last week's close, and the first sales, the buying of steel and the trading in copper stocks undoubtedly have taken the center of the stage, as the gigantic foreign contracts recently placed have put foreign contracts in an independent position for months to come.

In the rally New York Central was the advance leader with an opening at 100, against last week's close of 98 1/2, and in the first session made a new high mark, the other rail stocks were strong and fairly active, most of them being fractionally higher at the opening.

U. S. Steel went to the highest mark recorded in several years when it sold today at 100 1/2. The American Petroleum sold the highest in several months at 108 1/2.
