

5, 10, 15 CENT STORE TO OCCUPY THE YEON CORNER FOR 10 YEARS

Yeon Pays Rosenblatt Company \$5000 to Cancel Its Lease on Store.

MONTHLY RENTAL \$2200

Rosenblatt & Co. Has Leased Store in Falling Building Across Street; Space Is 80 Feet Square.

A company that is operating 5, 10 and 15 cent stores throughout the country, has rented the ground floor and basement of the Yeon building, Fifth and First streets, for a term of 10 years at \$2200 a month.

To effect the arrangement John R. Yeon yesterday paid Samuel Rosenblatt & Co. \$5000 for cancelling a lease held by them on the ground floor property.

Rosenblatt & Co. in turn have taken a lease on the ground floor of the structure directly across the street from the Yeon building, which is owned by the Esting estate.
