

GERMAN SOCIALISTS SEEK FREEDOM FROM CENSORSHIP OF PRESS

Spontaneous Declaration Regarding Reform of Prussian Franchise Expected.

Berlin, Jan. 11.—(U. N. S.)—(Via London)—A prelude to the coming debate in the reichstag on the censorship took place in the budget committee, which discussed the Socialist resolution asking for the raising of the state of siege, and the restoration of the freedom of the press.

Socialists, progressives and conservative speakers criticized the application of the censorship, the Socialists particularly complaining that the censors often proved against articles advocating an early peace and that they have greatly hampered discussion of the food problem.

The report is current that the government will take occasion at the coming session of the Prussian diet to make a spontaneous declaration regarding the reform of the Prussian electoral franchise. Agitation against the three class system has been taken up with increased energy since the outbreak of the war.

Body of Student Is Found Upon Beach

Body Tied Around Waist of Gordon Osborn, Tacoma, Puzzles Coroner Investigating Death; Missing Two Weeks.

Tacoma, Wash., Jan. 11.—(P. N. S.)—A rope tied around the waist of Gordon Osborn was today puzzling Coroner Stewart in his investigation following the finding of the youth's body on the beach north of old Tacoma yesterday afternoon. The boy had been missing two weeks. Deputy Coroner King advanced the belief that Osborn, while out duck hunting, feared the boat would capsize in the rough water off Point Defiance and had tied the rope about him to assist him in keeping his head above the surface of the water. The boat was not seen, Osborn was a business college student.

Japanese Druggist Blamed for Deaths

T. Takana Accused of Disposing of Wood Alcohol Since Prohibition Became Effective; Twelve Have Died.

Seattle, Wash., Jan. 11.—(P. N. S.)—T. Takana, manager of a drug store in the Japanese section of the city, is in the city jail and will face a charge of manslaughter for the alleged sale of wood alcohol as a beverage. Five men who claim that they bought alcohol from Takana are held as witnesses. The police allege that Takana has been the ring leader of a gang of bootleggers who have made a business of selling wood alcohol since the prohibition law became effective. Since January 1, twelve men have died from the effects of drinking wood alcohol or cheap whiskey substitutes.

Fell Out of His Bed; Caught Pneumonia

Quincy, Or., Jan. 11.—Lowry Wadsworth, the little son of Superintendent H. E. Wadsworth of the Indian school, is critically ill from pneumonia, having contracted a cold by falling out of bed and sleeping some time upon the floor during the recent cold spell.

Traps 1800 Gophers.
Quincy, Or., Jan. 11.—Claude Harris of Clear Lake has captured 1800 gophers during the last year. Besides the bounty he received from the county, in many instances he was paid an additional sum by farmers upon whose land he killed them. He has 200 traps set.

War Souvenirs Are Received by Portland Woman

Several souvenirs of the European war have been received by Mrs. O. C. Stevens of this city from her sister, Mrs. Henry Wilson of Kensington road, London. Several pieces of bombs that were dropped by Zeppelins on a relief station, where Mr. Wilson was working, are among the collection. Two unique handkerchiefs bordered with coat of arms and flags, samples of those sold for the benefit of the allies were also received. Mrs. Stevens has about 20 relatives at the front.

Hardware Store at Baker Suffers Fire

Lighted Match Thrown Into Crate of Goods Blamed for Blaze; Explosives Removed in the Wick of Time.

Baker, Or., Jan. 11.—Fire believed to have been started by a lighted match dropped into a crate of tinware, packed in straw, caused a fire early this morning, resulting in \$2000 loss to the Caldwell Hardware company. The fire smoldered for hours, finally communicating to bales of canvas tents and wagon covers. Heavy smoke pouring from the windows was seen by a reporter, who gave the alarm. The fire department made a hard fight to confine the flames to the Caldwell building. It was feared for a time that a quantity of powder and dynamite stored in the building might explode, but it was finally removed. The destroyed stock consisted of canvas goods, hardware, harness and saddlery.

Fire Bell Rope Was Short; Hose Clogged

Harrisburg Department Has Rather Difficult Time in Getting in Readiness After Alarm Is Raised.

Albany, Or., Jan. 11.—The town of Harrisburg in Linn county had a hard time fighting a fire at the home of M. B. Miller recently. Because the fire bell ropes, which are made of cotton, shrank up during the cold weather, some difficulty was experienced by the bell boys in ringing the bell. They were unable to reach the cords from the ground and had to climb up the tower. After nearly all the village folk and volunteer firemen had arrived at the scene in response to the bell and all was ready to shoot the stream, the nozzle suddenly became choked. It was discovered that some children at play had rolled rocks and pebbles in the hose as it lay on the draining board. The firefighters were delayed considerably by the water had to be turned off several times to remove the nozzle in order to get the rocks out. And at last only the roof of the Miller home was destroyed.

Receiver Asked for The Norman Hotels

Spokane, Wash., Jan. 11.—(P. N. S.)—Applications for a receiver for the Spokane hotel and other properties operated by the Norman Hotels company are on file in the courts here today. The German Savings & Loan society of San Francisco is plaintiff in the action, claiming to hold mortgages against the hotel company aggregating \$221,817. The hotel, Tacoma of Tacoma is one of the Norman Hotels company properties.

Major Hayden Dies.

Tacoma, Wash., Jan. 11.—(U. N. S.)—Prominent in local business activities for the last 28 years and widely known in the northwest, Major Obidiah Bennett Hayden is dead here today following an operation. Major Hayden was 73 years old and came here from Indiana. He was a Civil war veteran.

PORTO SAID WAS HIT WHEN RUNNING AWAY REPORT FROM VIENNA

Liner, Ordered to Stop, Tried to Ram Submarine and Escape, Is Claim.

Berlin, by wireless to Sayville, L. I., Jan. 11.—(U. N. S.)—Justification for torpedoing the Italian liner Porto Said was given in Vienna dispatches today, which declared an Austrian submarine sank her after she had tried to escape and to ram the undersea boat.

"The submarine first ordered the Porto Said to stop, but she attempted to escape," said the message. "Then she ran up a white flag and stopped. When the submarine approached, the steamer suddenly veered in order to ram her. The submarine fired and hit her after which she again stopped and began lowering her boats."

"Then the submarine stopped firing. Upon approaching, the submarine found that boats were pulling away without heeding those who were swimming. The submarine halted the boat containing the captain and threatened to shoot him if he did not return and save these people."

"The submarine for two persons aboard the steamer, one of whom was wounded. The latter was taken aboard the submarine and bandaged, and then transferred to the captain's boat. Only then was the Porto Said torpedoed. While the submarine was still aiding the people aboard the ship, the submarine was shelled by enemy torpedo boats and yachts."

London dispatches December 17 reported that the Porto Said had been submerged, but carried no details. She was a \$300 ton vessel.
