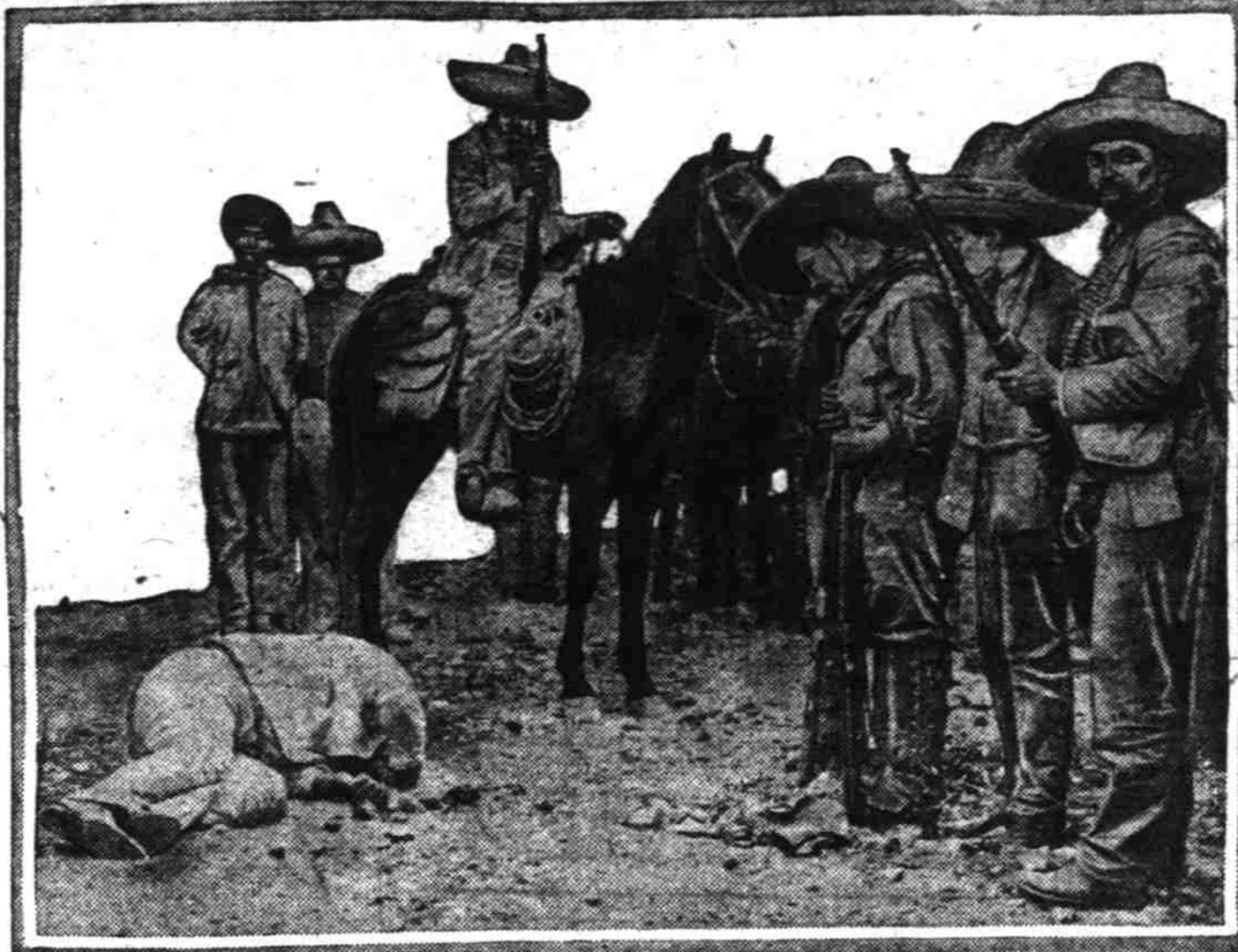

Two Russian Soldiers Have a Thrilling Time in Escaping From German Camp

London, Jan. 21.—Details were received today of a remarkable escape of two Russian prisoners of war, who had been brought into Belgium by the Germans and forced to assist in fortifying the lines.

Escape Is Made. Upon returning to the camp one evening the two young men decided to risk an escape. The sleeping hut was surrounded by barbed wire, and guarded by three sentries—German soldiers who had been invalided and made incapable for more active service—and the camp itself was patrolled.
