

URGES TUNNEL MEN TO NOTIFY COMPANY OF WISHES ON WORK

J. F. Fleming Declares "Agitators" Have Intimidated Would-Be Signers.

'STANDPAT' ACTION TAKEN

Meeting at Arion Hall Decides Not to Abate Stand for Increase in Wages at St. Johns.

Believing that an overwhelming majority of workmen are willing to go back to the St. Johns tunnel operations at the same wage scale that prevailed before the strike and lock-out, J. F. Fleming, 632 East Simon street, has asked that workmen who are tired of enforced idleness write

the contractors postal cards to indicate their wishes. "I cannot be called a 'scab,' as many of the agitators are calling men who are signing petitions to go back to work," said Mr. Fleming. "Because I am a member of the Western Federation of Miners and have been for nearly 30 years. Most of the men employed at the tunnel were satisfied and would be working there yet but for the agitators.

Says Agitators Filled Plan.

"A meeting called for Columbia park at which petitions were to be signed proved futile because the agitators there kept shouting 'scab,' and thereby intimidated men from signing. We have 500 signatures, at that. "So I would suggest that those who really want to go back to work write their names and working numbers on postcards and send to A. Guthrie & Co., the contractors. That will have the same effect as a petition without any of the trouble and intimidation."

Mr. Fleming denied that he is acting for the company in any way, not having even consulted any officer of A. Guthrie & Co.

Meeting Decided to "Stay."

About 150 tunnel workers held a meeting at Arion hall last night to discuss the situation. After a number of speeches, it was decided to work "stand pat" on the demands. The charge was made, however, that the men who are tired of idleness were

not fully represented at the meeting. Among those who spoke were V. H. Douthwaite, who urged a return to work; Simon Billings, who urged holding out for a pay increase; J. Britt Carthy, C. H. Miller and C. Carson. M. A. Hathaway presided.

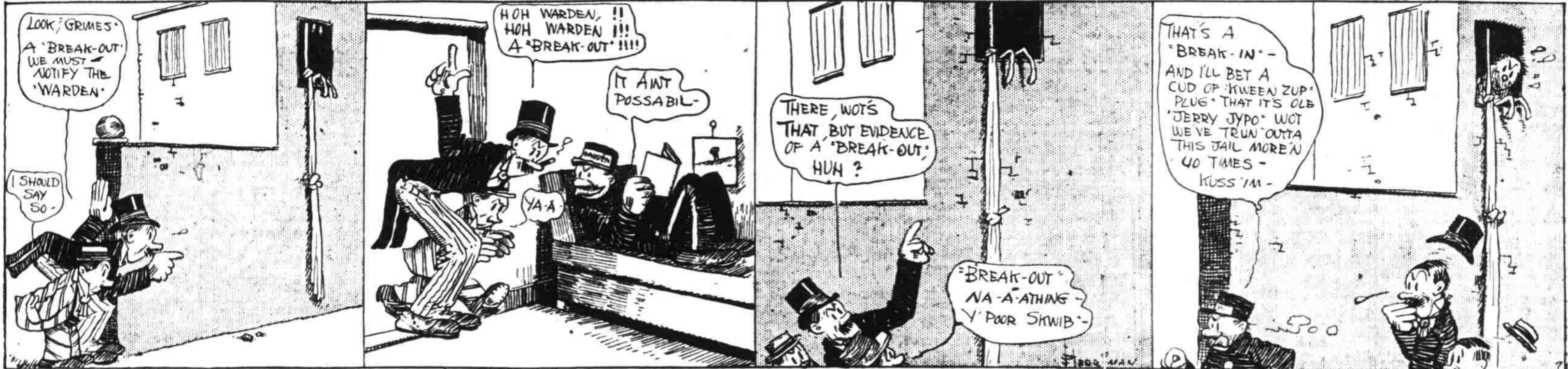

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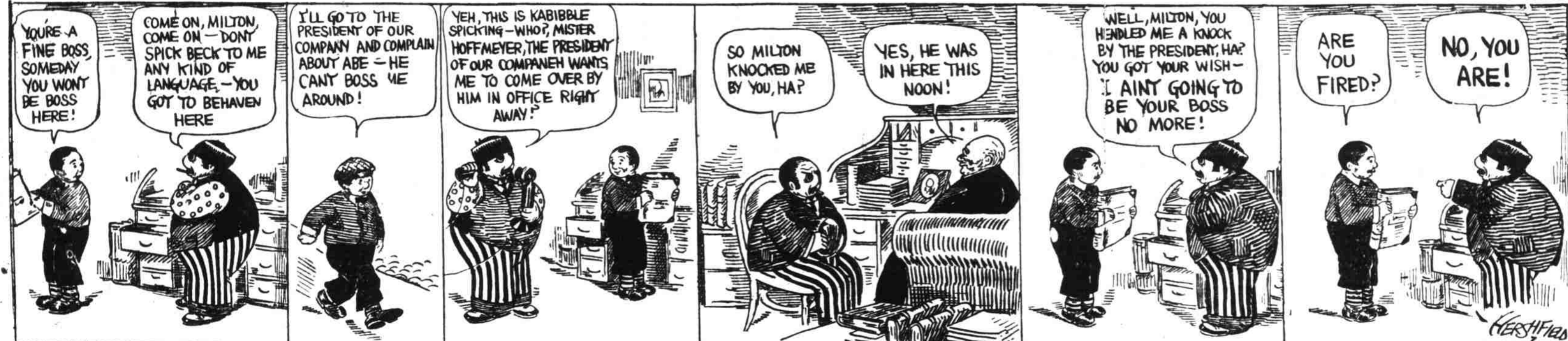

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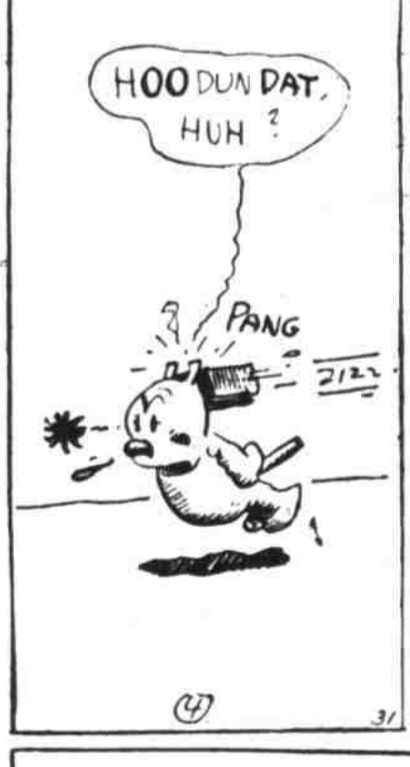
