## AMERICA NOT JOKING, SAYS PRESIDENT

Wilson Talks to West Point Cadets at Commencement Exercises, Urging the Necessity for Adequate Preparedness to Defend Ideals

## MILITARISM IS MATTER OF THE SPIRIT, HE SAYS

Cadets Are Told to Remember Always They Are American Citizens First, Not Soldiers Nor Officers; Blustering Nationalities Not Loved.

West Point, N. Y., June 12.—(U. P.)—"The world is going to know that when America speaks she means what she says," President Wilson told the military academy graduating class today. A moment before he had said: "Undoubtedly, gentlemen, it is the duty of America to be prepared."

President Wilson promised in behalf of the United States to uphold the Monroe doctrine. He promised, too, what he did not promise when he made the recent Peace League speech that when the time comes, America will be ready to join the other nations to see that "that kind of justice prevails everywhere that we believe in."

To be military does not mean militaristic, the president said. He asked the West Point men not to forget that they are citizens first.
