Weather Conditions.
 Although the pressure is decreasing along the north Pacific coast, it still is relatively high over that section, and also over eastern Canada and from the Mississippi valley to the Atlantic coast. The pressure has decreased over the southwest, Utah and the northern Rocky Mountain states and Alberta, and a V-shaped depression extends from Arizona to northern California, then northeastward to central Montana. Showers have fallen on the Washington coast, in western Canada, the Dakotas, Minnesota, Illinois, Utah, Colorado and along the Gulf and Atlantic coasts, and thunderstorms were reported from Arizona, California, Nevada, City, Huron, Missouri and Chicago. The weather is cooler on most of the Pacific slope, in the southern portion of the United States, and in the northern portion of Canada. In general it is warmer in other sections, especially Wyoming, South Dakota and northwestern Montana.

The conditions are favorable for showers in western Washington, and, generally, fair weather tonight and Wednesday if the remainder of this district. It will be cooler tonight in southeastern Idaho.
