Three Eggs Ahead of Leading Competitor—Take Third Prize for August.

The report of the 45th week of the laying contest at Storrs, Conn., shows the pen of "Oregon" again leading the 100 pens in the contest. Their score was 52 eggs and nearest competitor 49. The average of all pens was 45.2.

Storrs, Conn., Sept. 23.—In the forty-fifth week of the laying contest at Storrs the hens yielded 2025 eggs. The Agricultural college pen of "Oregon" from Corvallis, Or., were first for the week with a production of 52 eggs.

STATE'S EVIDENCE IN HYDE-BENSON CASES NOW ALL ASSEMBLED

Suits Involve 46,000 Acres in Seven Different Counties of Oregon.

Salem, Or., Sept. 23.—Evidence has been gathered at last for the trial of the suits of the state of Oregon to recover 46,000 acres of land involved in the Hyde-Benson cases.

Much of the testimony for the trials has been taken in the form of depositions, so that it can be used in each of the seven trials without undue expense.

Joseph O. Bailey, an assistant in the office of Attorney General Brown, has been engaged in gathering the evidence, following his appointment soon after Brown took office in January, 1915.

A great mass of testimony has been secured and no difficulty is anticipated in showing that the state is entitled to recover title to the lands.

Schools to Have Pamphlets. Salem, Or., Sept. 23.—Because undeveloped constitutional amendment pamphlets sent the registered voters can be returned only at considerable cost, Secretary of State Ocott is addressing a letter to the principals of schools of the towns from which

advices of non-delivery are received suggesting that they take the pamphlets for use of the students. By studying the various measures the pupils can acquaint themselves with one of the methods by which legislation is enacted in Oregon, as well as the character of laws which are proposed by the people.
