

EXCAVATION ON NEW POSTOFFICE SITE MAY BEGIN DURING THE DAY

Electric-Driven Pump Is Being Installed to Eliminate Any Water in Basement.

WORK DELAYED BY TESTS

Federal Supervision Requires That All Materials Entering Into Building Be First Analyzed at Washington.

C. J. Cook Co., to whom the contract for excavation on the new postoffice site has been let by Grant Fee, will probably start work with the mechanical shovels some time during the day.

With what little excavation has already been done by day labor, it has been found that the soil is not as soft as a sort of sponge, and has accumulated much underground water. The ground has largely been filled in at some prior time, and much sawdust, which acts as a rain storage, is beneath the surface soil.

In order to be on the safe side, an electric-driven pump has been installed on the south side of the site for the removal of any water that might accumulate in the basement. At present the work seems to be moving slow, which seems characteristic of government construction.

SUBMARINE BRINGS DOWN A ZEPPELIN IN MOST THRILLING WAY

Rudyard Kipling Missed This One When He Described England's Undersea Boats.

London, Oct. 9.—(I. N. S.)

Quite satisfying to the most hardened reader is the plain story of the first submarine to bag a Zeppelin, as told by a representative of the British official press bureau. The details of this Jules Verne exploit are now made public for the first time. The story is as follows:

"When Rudyard Kipling wrote his thrilling stories of the doings of British submarines he confessed to being haphazard from the admiralty papers to which he had access, and that his 'tales' by no means exhausted the possibilities of what a submarine could do, and that it was just as likely that Kipling by his haphazard method missed a real beauty—the first story of how a submarine, the E-31, in one great adventure destroyed a Zeppelin, dodged a cruiser, and missed destruction herself by a bare inch.

"E-31 was lying on the bottom some where in the North sea, when her commander thought he would as well as go on 'top'. So he popped up. Her luck was in. There just came to the northwest, only two or three hundred yards away, flying very low, a great airship, the Zeppelin L-7, fresh from her expedition to the north of England.

"So E-31 decided not to show herself too much. But just to keep her eye on the prey, she started making a hop across the water. Just as the Zeppelin L-7 was about to clear the water of the North sea, the E-31 emerged and let fly at the Zeppelin at a range of about 100 yards with a 12-pounder. The first shot blew away the center gondola. The second shot destroyed the engine. The L-7 collapsed, and, burning fiercely, plunged headlong into the waters of the North sea.

Earlier in the day the federal authorities had been notified that cyanide had closed the hatches with a warning was sent out to allow any of the crew near the coal bunkers.
