

STATE DELEGATION OF MULTNOMAH COUNTY SOLIDLY REPUBLICAN

All Primary Nominees Are Chosen, Farrell Heading Ticket for State Senate.

LEWIS IS JOINT SENATOR

Highest Popular Vote Reached by Gill, Chosen State Senator for Short Term to Succeed Langruth.

Robert S. Farrell tops Multnomah county's senatorial ticket, with the exception of John Gill who was elected to a short term with no opposition other than the Socialist candidate.

John M. Mann leads the group of 12 state representatives elected in this county. The delegation is solid Republican.

For joint senator the two candidates ran as independents, H. L. Lewis defeating H. M. Patton.

JUDGE GATENS AGAIN CHOSEN BY A MARGIN OF 4703 OVER GRANT

Proves to Be Only Democrat to Be Elected to Any Office in Multnomah County.

Complete unofficial returns from all the precincts in Multnomah county show that Judge W. N. Gatens was re-elected circuit judge, department five, by a majority of 4703 votes over Frank W. Grant, his Republican opponent, Judge Gatens is the only Democrat who carried the county. All the other Republican candidates for state and judicial offices carried the county by large pluralities. Elect Their Entire List of Candidates From District Attorney to Constable.

BEVERIDGE A BIG WINNER

Dana Loses for County Clerk by Margin of 10,000 Votes—Complete Unofficial Returns.

The entire Republican county ticket, from district attorney to constable, was elected in Multnomah. The two chief contests were for school superintendent and county clerk. Joseph W. Beveridge, Republican, defeated Marshall N. Dana, Independent, for county clerk by more than 10,000 votes, while W. C. Alderson, Republican, captured the office of county school superintendent with a plurality of \$561 over J. O. Hall, Independent.

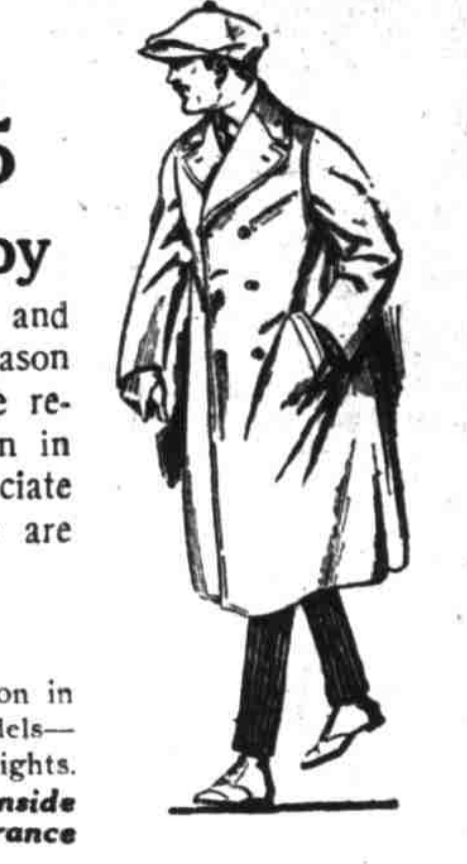

MULTNOMAH RESULTS ON MEASURE SHOWN; RETURNS ARE ALL IN

Multnomah county's complete vote on the initiative and referendum measures, as computed from all of the 875 precincts of the county, shows the biggest individual majority to have been registered against the enactment of the full rental land tax law, the negative majority being 43,878. The measure which ran closest in the county was the Brewer's amendment, against the adoption of which is registered a majority of 2173. Election Results Please Socialists

Leaders Claim 1,250,000 Votes and the Capture of Several Demisable Offices; 65,000 Votes in New York Alone.

New York, Nov. 10.—(U. P.)—Nearly a million and a quarter votes were cast by Socialists Tuesday, according to New York leaders, who based their estimate on still incomplete returns. Up to today they said 1,250,000 had been accounted for. In Indiana, they said the same leaders claimed official counts may show they elected three congressmen, 35 state legislators, the mayor of Minneapolis and several state candidates. They claimed to have cast 65,000 votes in New York state alone. In Milwaukee they say they elected the district attorney, sheriff, two state senators and seven assemblymen. Although leaders admittedly were disappointed over the congressional race of Eugene V. Debs in Indiana, they were greatly elated over the fact that in three New York districts their candidates ran close seconds.
