LEAGUE FOR PURPOSE OF PERMANENT PEACE APPROVED BY BRYCE

Says Britain Not to Be Ready Until Decisive Victory but Is Making Ready.

London, Nov. 15.—Approval of the proposal that "a combination of peaceful nations" be formed at the close of the war for the purpose of establishing a permanent peace was voiced last night by Viscount Bryce, foreign ambassador to the United States, at the meeting of the Mayflower Club, an organization of Americans and Britons in honor of the Pilgrims.

"Already many leading statesmen have proposed such a scheme," he said. "Both Mr. Wilson and Mr. Hughes have given it their hearty approval, public opinion in both parties alike is daily growing in its favor.

"Here in Great Britain we cannot take practical steps till this war has been—as it certainly will be—fought through to decisive victory. But meantime we may begin to consider what those practical steps would be and we may begin to consider the strength of our sympathy with their scheme and our willingness to cooperate in a work to which our common ideals turn."

Professor Gilbert Murray of Oxford discussed the American attitude as he discovered it during a recent visit to the United States, giving his approval to the proposed peace league and saying that he did not believe hatred would be lasting between the nations at war.
