

JASON MOORE GIVEN ONE MORE EXTENSION ON LEASE OF LAKES

Secretary of State Olcott Opposes Action but Withycombe and Kay Win Out.

NO DEFINITE TIME IS SET

This is Seventh Time That Operator Has Been Given Opportunity to Make Good on Undertaking.

Salem, Or., Dec. 15.—Over the protests of Secretary of State Olcott, Governor Withycombe and State Treasurer Kay, the state land board decided today to give Jason Moore further time in which to post \$15,000 as a balance of a bond of \$25,000 to insure the carrying out of the terms of his lease of Summer and Abert lakes.

An extension of 65 days expired today, and State Senator Orton of Portland appeared before the board in behalf of the Moore interests and asked a further extension.

circumstances would he vote for another extension and he proposed to be consistent. He also said that he wanted the matter closed before the legislature met.

"Let them come through with \$15,000," said the secretary.

Olcott said that the board had been granting extensions for nearly two years, and saw no reason why the lease matter should not be closed up before the legislature meets.

Kay Is Heard.
Kay said that he did not favor making an extension for any definite time, but thought that, in view of the fact that development work was going on, it would do no harm to take no action toward cancelling the lease, and let the legislature act as it saw fit. Despite all the money business about the lake lease, the fact remained that there was \$10,000 in the school fund, paid in by the Moore interests, and it was there permanently, Kay said.

Withycombe said that while he agreed with Olcott that Moore was not entitled to a further extension, no one else wanted the lakes, and it would do no harm to refrain from cancelling the lease at this time.

According to Orton, Moore and his associates have spent \$100,000 on the lake proposition, and they are awaiting the result of chemical tests before investing more.
The lease with Moore was executed December 16, 1914. Six extensions were granted previous to today. The failure to take action today means an indefinite extension.
