Ofcott said that the board had been granting extensions for nearly two rears, and saw no reason why the ease matter should not be closed up before the legislature meets. Kay Is Reard,

Kay said that he did not favor making an extension for any definite time, but thought that, in view of the fact that development work was going on, it would do no harm to take no action toward cancelling the lease, and let he legislature act as it saw fit. Despite all the money business about the lake lease, the fact remained that there was \$10,000 in the school fund, paid in by the Moore interests, and it was there permanently, Kay said. Withycombe said that while he

agreed with Olcott that Moore was not entitled to a further extension, no one else wanted the lakes, and it would do no harm to refrain from canceling the lease at this time.

According to Orton, Moore and his

associates have spent \$100,000 on the lake proposition, and they are awaiting the result of chemical tests before investing more.
