The rector of St. David's parish, East Twelfth and Belmont, will continue the subject of "Divorce and Remarriage," upon which he preached last Sunday.

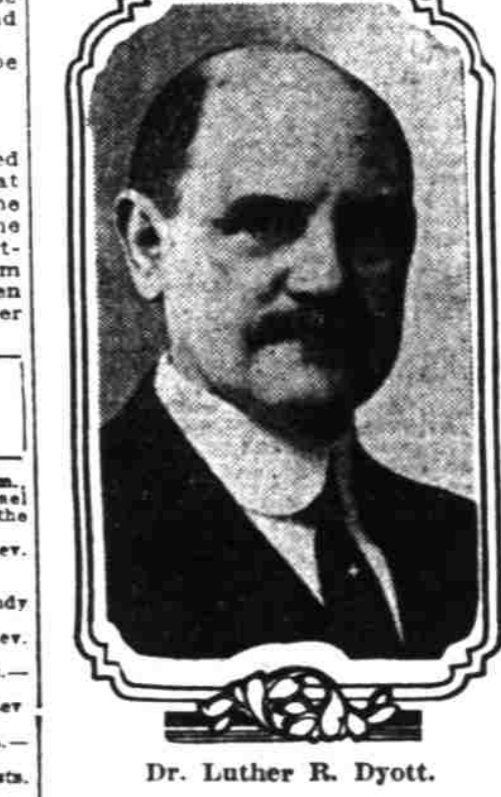
St. James Lutheran Church Reception
