

## COAST LEAGUERS OFF TO GRAND START WITH MAJOR LEAGUE CREWS

Those Who Went Up This Year Knock Stuffing Out of Old Horsehide.

## PORTLAND REPRESENTED

McCredie's Graduates Among Top-notchers When First Averages Are Compiled for Major Tossers.

Chicago, April 21.—The first week of the major league baseball season saw former Pacific Coast league ball players performing with the topnotchers in every department, no fewer than four who came up this year being among the leaders.

Tris Speaker started off again to duplicate his batting championship of last year, ending the first six games with an average of .400, 22 points ahead of Roger Peckinpaugh, former Portlander. Of the players who went up this year, Reuther, Portland, .364; Bates, formerly of Portland, and Verdon, is hitting .350; Gusto, of Portland, .333, and Bodie of San Francisco, .304. "Cuke" Ward of Portland led the National league in sacrificing for Pittsburg, with four suicides, the same number polled by Jack Barry of Boston in the American league.

Bodie Tied for Honors.

Leibold of Chicago and Hohlitzel of Boston lead in stolen bases, with three each. Cobb has two. Barry of Boston tops the list in runs scored with eight. Sisler of St. Louis, Schalk of Chicago, Hohlitzel and Walker of Boston, Jackson of Chicago and Bodie of Philadelphia are tied for home run honors with one each. Walker, Boston, leads in total bases with 17. Chicago leads in club batting with a percentage of .268 and in fielding with .938.

The leading batters are Speaker, Cleveland, .400; Peckinpaugh, New York, .375; Bates, Philadelphia, .360; Pipp, New York, .353; McInnis, Philadelphia, .348; Walker, Boston, .346; Cobb, Detroit, .323; Gusto, Cleveland, .323; Hohlitzel, Boston, .323; Judge, Washington, .323; Lewis, Boston, .320; Schalk, Chicago, .318; Felsch, Chicago, .318; Strunk, Philadelphia, .318; Sisler, St. Louis, .315; Bodie, Philadelphia, .304.

Look Out for Kauff.

Hank Gowdy of Boston leads the National league batters with an average of .600, with Benny Kauff, New York, second with .558.

Baird, Pittsburg, leads in runs scored with six. Chicago, Cincinnati, leads in total bases with 20. Duguey, Cravath and Luderus, all of Philadelphia; Robertson, New York; Koenig, Boston; and Hornsby, St. Louis, have one homer each.

The stolen base record shows five tied with two each. They are Baird, Pittsburg; Zeider, Chicago; Long, St. Louis; Schulte, Pittsburg; and Carey, Pittsburg.

The plan upon which the St. Louis Cardinals management will work this year with regard to the issuing of passes to youngsters is a commendable one.

"It will give them a chance to learn more of the game," says the governor, "and make substantial baseball fans out of them for the future."

Although the professional baseball leagues of the country are going ahead with their plans regardless of the war, college baseball has suffered this year, as most of the big schools of the country, cancelled baseball schedules and disbanded their teams when war was declared.
